

Progress in NAPs by the LDCs (overall picture)

All the 46 LDCs are undertaking at least one measure in the process to formulate and implement NAPs

- ☐ For most LDCs, progress stalled after initial activities under Element A on laying the groundwork and addressing gaps
- Most countries could not receive immediate support for subsequent assessments and other activities which require greater resources

While there is overall increase in activities in NAPs across the developing countries, and expansion of support opportunities, the LDCs continue to face challenges in making swift progress in formulating and implementing their NAPs

LDCs are benefiting from direct support in advancing their NAP

- During the pandemic, the LEG has continued to work with the 18 LDCs that participated in Nairobi workshop in 2019 to advance on their NAP, virtually
- The demand is increasing, and the LDCs are finding this approach very useful in addressing their individual unique circumstances

Early results

- Many LDCs are progressing despite the constraints of COVID
- Several draft NAPs being commented on, and expect a good number of NAPs to be submitted by end of the year
- Some LDCs have successfully received approval for implementation of their NAP priorities under the GCF. Many are thinking about how to best advance in implementation, in parallel to finalizing their first NAP

The Open NAP initiative

- The Open NAP initiative is proving to be very useful in mobilizing support from many sides. Organizations, regional centers and networks, other experts alike
- This is dramatically increasing the breadth of technical assistance available to the LDCs in their adaptation efforts

- The collaboration across different support programmes through the NAP Technical Working Group is improving coordination of support and coherence in approaches.
- The partners are providing inputs through commenting on drafts, and also co-organizing support activities
