- ODI co-published a 2017 paper that explored ways of **financing the transition from brown, carbon-intensive models of economic development to low-carbon, green economies**. - Another five-year ODI programme explored the **effectiveness of global efforts to finance climate action** in climate vulnerable countries from 2011- 2016.
