Registration/Badge collection

Upon first arrival at the Yeosu Expo Convention Centre, participants are requested to proceed to the registration desk located in the lobby of Building C (main entrance to the Climate Week premises) to collect their conference badge.

For subsequent visits, participants in possession of a valid badge may access the venue directly without returning to the registration desk.

Registration desk opening hours

- Sunday, 19 April and Monday, 20 April 2026: 12:00 – 18:00 hrs.
- Tuesday, 21 April to Saturday, 25 April 2026: from 07:00 – 18:00 hrs.

Funding arrangements

Funded participants invited to the Peer Exchange Workshop on NDC Implementation will be provided with:

- Flights (round-trip),
- Daily subsistence allowance (DSA) in accordance with United Nations travel policies.

Daily subsistence allowance (DSA)

The DSA will be provided to all eligible funded participants registered by the deadline of April 02, 2026.

DSA will cover costs associated with participation in the **two-day Peer Exchange Workshop only**. Further details on the disbursement modalities will be communicated directly to participants by email.

Accommodation

Participants are responsible for making their own accommodation arrangements during the period of the event and cover these costs through the DSA.

Meals

Participants may cover their meal expenses through the DSA.

Water dispensers will be provided by the Host Country throughout the venue. Participants are encouraged to bring their own water bottles.

Please note that food and beverages are not permitted inside any of the meeting rooms.

Flight tickets

A round flight ticket is provided to all funded participants by the organizing Partners: UNFCCC secretariat, UNDP and GIZ. Your flight arrangement will begin once your registration has been approved in Indico.

Please note that boarding passes must be presented when collecting DSA, as indicated above.

Transportation from/to airport

Participants may use their DSA to cover transportation expenses.

On-site transportation

Google Maps may have limited functionality in the Republic of Korea. Participants are therefore advised to use **Naver Maps** (available in English) or **KakaoMap**, which provide detailed navigation information, particularly for public transportation.

Taxis are widely available in Yeosu and are generally the most convenient means of transportation within the city. Ride-hailing services such as **Kakao T** or **K-Ride** may also be used. Limited Uber services may be available.

Public transportation options, including buses, are also available.

The Expo Convention Centre is approximately a 10-minute walk from the Venezia Hotel.

Other general information

Weather:

In April, Yeosu experiences mild spring weather, with daytime temperatures ranging from 16°C to 20°C (61°F -68°F) and nighttime temperatures between 9°C–11°C (47°F–52°F). While April is not part of the peak rainy season, occasional rainfall can be expected. Participants are advised to bring light layers and a compact umbrella.

Currency:

The official currency of the Republic of Korea is the South Korean won (KRW). Foreign currency can be exchanged at authorized banks and licensed foreign exchange bureaus during standard banking hours (typically 09:00-16:00 hrs, Monday to Friday).

As of 2 April 2026, the approximate exchange rate is: 1 USD = 1516.15 KRW.

Banking/Credit Cards:

Credit cards are usually accepted throughout Korea. Visa Cards are generally the most commonly accepted. Please note that Apple Pay may not work.

Automated Teller Machines (ATMs) are available for cash withdrawals at the Yeosu Expo Convention Centre, the Yeosu Venezia Hotel, and Shilla Stay Hotel.

While Korea is a highly digital society, it is advisable to carry some cash for use in small shops, traditional markets, and certain local transportation services.

Electricity:

The standard electricity supply in Korea is 220 volts at 60Hz.

The most commonly used plug types are:

- Type F (two round pins with earth clips on side; also called "Schuko".)
- Type C (two round pins; widely used internationally, also known as the "Europlug")

Participants travelling from countries using 110–120 volts may require a plug adapter and, depending on their devices, a voltage converter.

Connectivity:

The international dialing code for the Republic of Korea is +82. Yeosu has extensive mobile network coverage provided by major carriers such as SK Telecom, KT, and LG U+. Mobile services are reliable, and both local SIM cards and eSIM options are widely available.

Translation:

If you need to translate text from Korean to English, the Papago application may be useful. ([Papago](#))

Health:

Participants are responsible for obtaining their own comprehensive international medical insurance for the duration of their stay.

Sustainability:

Participants are encouraged to print and photocopy only what is absolutely necessary prior to and during the sessions.

Participants are asked to refrain from distributing any printed materials, such as publications and information related to side events, other meetings, or future conferences. Any dissemination of information should be done electronically.
