



Twenty-fifth meeting of the Executive Committee of the Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage associated with Climate Change Impacts

14–18 September 2026

Majuro, Republic of the Marshall Islands

Meeting venue

The meeting will take place at the Marshall Islands Resort in Majuro, the Republic of the Marshall Islands as from Monday 14 September to Friday 18 September 2026.

Identification badges and registration

The location of registration and the conference will be at the Melele Room at MIR. It is on the second floor to the far-right end side of the MIR resort.

Opening hours of the registration counter

For in-person participants, registration will take place at Melele Room of the Marshall Islands Resort at 8 am on Monday 14 September 2026. All registered participants will receive their conference badge for the duration of the meeting at registration.

Accommodation

Rates at the Marshall Island Resort hotel are as follows:

1. Regular rate: \$127.20 after tax
2. Room w/ Breakfast(1Pax): \$150.96 after tax
3. Room w/ Breakfast(2Pax): \$172.56. after tax

How to get to the meeting venue

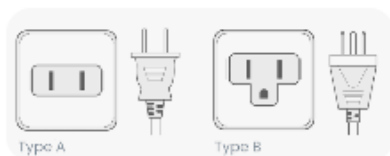
If participants choose to stay at residences outside of Marshall Islands Resort, they are welcome to either rent a vehicle with the Robert Reimers Hotel (this can be inquired while confirming booking) or they can take a taxi. Taxis are caught by standing by the side of the road and holding a hand up to catch passing taxi drivers' attention. There are many taxis passing and should be easy to catch. Taxis only accept cash in US dollars (USD)

Time in the Marshall Islands, an island country consisting of over 29 coral atolls, is in Marshall Islands Time (MHT) zone, which is UTC+12:00. The Marshall Islands does not have an associated daylight-saving time.
