Thirtieth meeting of the Adaptation Committee (AC 30)

14–17 September 2026

Baku, Azerbaijan

Information for participants

Meeting dates and time

The [thirtieth meeting of the Adaptation Committee \(AC 30\)](#) will take place from **14 to 17 September 2026** in Baku, Azerbaijan.

Meeting time: 09:00–18:00, Azerbaijan time (AZT/UTC+4), unless otherwise indicated in the meeting schedule.

Please note: AC 30 is a separate meeting from [UNFCCC Climate Week 4](#).

Climate Week 4 will take place from **7 to 11 September 2026** at the **Baku Convention Center**, whereas AC 30 will take place from **14 to 17 September 2026** at the [Baku Marriott Hotel Boulevard](#). Participation and registration arrangements for the two events are separate.

Observer attendance: Observer attendance will commence at **14:00 on Monday, 14 September** and continue through **Thursday, 17 September 2026**.

Accessing the venue

Participants are encouraged to arrive at the venue sufficiently in advance to allow time for registration and access procedures. Access to the meeting rooms is restricted to registered AC 30 participants.

Meeting badges can be collected at the registration desk at the venue upon arrival. Participants are encouraged to complete registration on the first day before the opening of the meeting.

Accommodation

Participants are responsible for ensuring that their accommodation arrangements are in place, unless alternative arrangements have been communicated directly to them.

The Government of the Republic of Azerbaijan has secured **special corporate hotel rates for registered AC 30 participants** for the period:

Booking instructions and applicable rates are being communicated directly to registered participants. Reservations are subject to availability and are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

Travel to Baku

The main international point of entry is [Heydar Aliyev International Airport \(GYD\)](#).

The Baku Marriott Hotel Boulevard is approximately **23.7 km from the airport**. The hotel does not provide a complimentary airport shuttle.

By taxi: Official airport taxis are available from the designated taxi area outside **Terminal 1**.

By bus: Participants may use the **AeroExpress** airport bus service to central Baku; onward transportation (taxi or metro) is required to reach the meeting venue in Khatai District.

Participants are encouraged to allow sufficient travel time, particularly during peak traffic periods.

Transportation in Baku

Baku has a subway train system and public buses. There are many taxi companies also operating. BOLT and UBER apps operate effectively in Baku. The local functional taxi company 189 is reliable and reasonably safe.

Visa and entry requirements

Participants are responsible for ensuring that they meet the applicable **visa, passport and entry requirements for Azerbaijan** before travelling.

Nationals of eligible countries may apply for an electronic visa through the **official ASAN Visa portal of the Republic of Azerbaijan**. A standard e-Visa should be applied for at least **three working days before arrival**. The e-Visa is single-entry and permits a stay of up to **30 days**. The travel document used must remain valid for at least **three months beyond the expiry date of the e-Visa**.

Participants should check the latest requirements applicable to their nationality before making travel arrangements.

Please note: the dedicated visa arrangements announced for registered Climate Week 4 participants relate to Climate Week 4 and should not be assumed to apply automatically to AC 30 participants.

Working language of the meeting

The meeting will be conducted in English, and no interpretation will be provided.



Practical information

Time zone	Azerbaijan Time (AZT), UTC+4.
Currency	The official currency is the Azerbaijani manat (AZN). Credit and debit cards are widely accepted in Baku, and ATMs are readily available. Participants may nevertheless wish to carry a small amount of local currency for incidental expenses.
Telephone country code	+994
Power voltage	220 V, 50 Hz. Plug types C and F (two round pins). A travel adapter is required for appliances using type A/B (e.g. North American) plugs.
Weather	September in Baku is generally warm, with average daytime temperatures of approximately 25–28°C and nighttime temperatures of around 18–20°C. Participants are advised to check the weather forecast shortly before travelling.

Communications equipment, mobile phone networks, internet

There are three main providers of mobile services (Azercell/Bakcell/Narmobile). Mobile phones with SIM cards and mobile/internet packages can be purchased at local mobile phone shops (providing an ID card). Mobile phones that are used with local SIM cards must be registered after 30 days; otherwise, they won't function

Health, safety and insurance

Participants are strongly encouraged to have appropriate **international medical and travel insurance** covering the duration of their stay in Azerbaijan.

Participants are also expected to familiarize themselves with and observe the **UNFCCC Code of Conduct for events**, including the requirement to maintain a professional and respectful environment for all participants.
