What is the TF-CLIMA?

- •Time-bound initiative under Brazil's G20 Presidency (2024)
- Sherpa and Finance tracks together
- Foreign Affairs; Climate & Environment;
 Finance Ministries and Central Banks



What is TF-CLIMA trying to respond to?

- Maximizing changes of 1.5oC
- First Global Stocktake
- G20: 80% of global GDP and of GHG emissions
- Diverse group: developing and developed countries
- Systemic, structural issues



Who takes part of TF-CLIMA?

- •G20 members
- •15 guest countries
- 25 international organizations and mission-oriented coalitions



How has TF-CLIMA worked?

- 4 technical meetings
- Information sessions
- Joint Ministerial (24 Oct)
- Group of Experts (independent)



Thematic issues

- Resetting action: transition planning and country platforms
- Resetting finance: measures to align financial flows with climate action
- Summary of climate-related outcomes of other working groups under both tracks

<u>Outcomes</u>

- Ministerial Statement
- Outcome document: an agenda for the G20 to keep 1.5oC within reach
- Report of the Group of Experts (independent)



Outcome document

- Principles for transition planning and country platforms
- Measures and actions on regulatory frameworks, reducing the cost of capital, MDBs
- Non-binding recommendations to guide action



Preliminary assessement

- General agreement that uniting the two tracks was helpful
- Not starting from zero
- Path is clear need swift implementation and more work on structural issues
