WHY: Cannondale Drapac's <2 and the UN-REDD Programme have joint forces to draw attention to the annual forest loss of some 8 million hectares of tropical forests – an area the size of Austria. With the loss of forests comes the loss of biodiversity and of ecosystem services for human communities. In addition, degraded forests cannot play their crucial climate change mitigation role. The forest, agriculture and land-use sector is responsible for almost 25% of anthropogenic GHG.
