Invitation to the first global dialogue and the first investment-focused event under the Sharm el-Sheikh mitigation ambition and implementation work programme

3-5 June 2023

On behalf of the co-chairs of the Sharm el-Sheikh mitigation ambition and implementation work programme, Amr Osama Abdel-Aziz and Lola Vallejo, I am pleased to invite constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs), to participate in the first global dialogue and the first investment-focused event under the work programme.

The first global dialogue will take place on **3 and 4 June 2023** in a hybrid format, with the in-person element taking place in Bonn. The investment-focused event will be held in Bonn on **5 June 2023**.

The first global dialogue is being organized pursuant to decision 4/CMA.4, by which the CMA decided that at least two global dialogues shall be held each year as part of the work programme and requested the secretariat to organize those dialogues under the guidance of the co-chairs of the work programme. Pursuant to the same decision, the co-chairs of the work programme have selected the topics to be discussed at each dialogue in 2023. The dialogues in 2023 will focus on accelerating just energy transition, including by:

- Implementing policies and measures with global overview and country-specific experience;
- Addressing financial, technological and capacity-building needs in this area, such as through international cooperation, including with non-Party stakeholders, and provision of support to developing countries;
- Promoting sustainable development and understanding socioeconomic effects.

Nomination and registration details

Representatives of admitted NGOs nominated by constituency focal points (CFPs) must register for the first global dialogue and the investment focused event using the observer registration form for NGOs, which will be sent to the CFPs. Kindly note that, owing to the capacity constraints, **two representatives per constituency will be permitted to participate as observers in the global dialogue and investment focused event, one in-person and one virtually**. CFPs are requested to nominate one participant from a developed country and one participant from a developing country from their constituency. Upon receiving the completed registration forms, CFPs should confirm the nominations and email the forms to cool@unfccc.int. no later than **Friday**, **19 May 2023**. For those who are not nominated and are interested in following the global dialogue and investment-focused event, it will also be broadcast live.
