## **MESSAGE TO UNITED NATIONS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS**

### **The third global dialogue and the third investment-focused event under the Sharm el-Sheikh mitigation ambition and implementation work programme**

**27 – 29 May 2024**

On behalf of the co-chairs of the Sharm el-Sheikh mitigation ambition and implementation work programme, Amr Osama Abdel-Aziz and Lola Vallejo, I am pleased to inform United Nations and related organizations, specialized agencies and admitted intergovernmental organizations, that the third global dialogue and investment-focused event under the work programme will take place on **27 - 29 May 2024** in a hybrid format in Bonn. A full-day session is planned for 27 May and two half-day sessions are planned on 28 and 29 May.

The third global dialogue is being organized pursuant to decision 4/CMA.4, by which the CMA decided that at least two global dialogues shall be held each year as part of the work programme and requested the secretariat to organize those dialogues under the guidance of the co-chairs of the work programme. Pursuant to the same decision, the co-chairs of the work programme have selected the topics “Cities: buildings and urban systems” to be discussed at each dialogue in 2024.

For those interested in following, the global dialogue and investment-focused event will be broadcast live.
