This informal note has been prepared by the co-facilitators under their own responsibility and has no formal status. It is an attempt by the co-facilitators to capture the discussions under these agenda items at the sixty-second sessions of the subsidiary bodies. This informal note does not prejudge the draft decision, which will be prepared at SB 63 and forwarded for consideration and adoption by the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement at its seventh session, neither does it prejudge further work or prevent Parties from expressing their views at any time. It does not represent agreement among Parties and is without prejudice to what will form the basis of negotiations.

The co-facilitators would like to highlight that the objective of the Sharm el-Sheikh mitigation ambition and implementation work programme shall be to urgently scale up mitigation ambition and implementation in this critical decade in a manner that complements the global stocktake.

Further, the MWP shall be operationalized through focused exchanges of views, information and ideas, noting that the outcomes of the work programme will be non-prescriptive, non-punitive, facilitative, respectful of national sovereignty and national circumstances, take into account the nationally determined nature of nationally determined contributions and will not impose new targets or goals.

Decision 4/CMA.4, paragraph 5, decided that implementation of the work programme will start immediately after the fourth session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement and continue until its eighth session (2026) with a view to adopting a decision on the continuation of the work programme at that session.
