Manja has been with the UN for ten years, both in the field and headquarters, working on humanitarian coordination, partnerships, strategic planning as well as climate change issues. In January 2021, she became Head of the United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA) Philippines, where she has been since 2019 as Deputy Head. Prior she has been working for five years with OCHA Geneva on humanitarian coordination mechanisms and partnerships with the private sector.
