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MESSAGE TO PARTIES AND OBSERVER STATES

Nomination for participants to mandated events and information on other events

Climate Week - 4 Baku, Azerbaijan, 7 - 11 September 2026

The secretariat refers to the [Message to Parties and observers](#) dated 29 January 2026 regarding the Climate Weeks- in 2026, as well as the communication dated 11 March, informing that Climate Week -4 will be held from 7 to 11 September 2026 in Baku, Azerbaijan.

This message to Parties includes information on mandated events taking place during Climate Week-4 that are open for nomination of Party representatives, and the corresponding participation modalities, as well as mandated and other events and their participation modalities. All mandated events will be organized in accordance with their respective mandates under the Conference of Parties serving as the meeting of Parties to the Paris Agreement and of the Subsidiary Bodies. The complete overview programme for Climate Week-4 is available [here](#). Detailed information on each event will also be made available on the general [events webpage](#) and on the dedicated webpage of the respective event.

Climate Week-4 will also host the [Implementation Forum](#), with the overall objective to focus on actionable solutions, bringing together implementers and policymakers to accelerate climate action. More information on the Forum can be found in annex III.

Participation in most mandated events is facilitated through the [National Focal Points \(NFPs\)](#), who are requested to ensure the effective nomination of the participants for the mandated events. Some mandated events have other nomination processes. In this context, Parties are invited to carefully review the information contained in annexes I to III of this communication.

All foreign participants entering the Republic of Azerbaijan must hold a passport valid for at least six months from the date of entry into the Republic of Azerbaijan.

Party delegates registered for in-person participation and that require a visa to travel to the Republic of Azerbaijan are strongly encouraged to contact the competent Republic of Azerbaijan mission or consular authorities as soon as possible to allow sufficient time for the necessary visas (and transit visas if required) to be issued.

Participants are also strongly encouraged to obtain comprehensive international medical insurance for their period of participation. The United Nations and the UNFCCC secretariat disclaim all responsibility for medical, accident and travel insurance, for compensation for death or disability, for loss of or damage to personal property and for any other costs or losses that may be incurred during travel or the period of participation.

Annex I

Nomination for mandated events

Nomination of representatives to mandated events, including those for which funding support is available, should be submitted through the centralised **the Indico UN nomination platform ([link](#))**, which compiles the nomination forms for all events open for nomination; for ease of reference, the individual event nomination forms are also available below in their respective sections. **Indico UN is the only official channel for nominating participants for the events during the Climate Week-4.** The secretariat is not in a position to process nominations submitted by any other method. Please note that it is imperative that a correct and unique email address be provided for each nominated participant for swift processing of nominations and initiating the registration process. Once a participant has been nominated for an event, they will receive an email with registration details via Indico UN. Logistical details related to travel and participation will be shared directly with registered participants and published on the [Climate Week-4 webpage](#).

Parties are encouraged to nominate individuals with expertise and experience relevant to each specific event. To ensure the effective use of funding arrangements available to eligible Parties, NFPs are invited to nominate distinct delegates to events with available funding for eligible Parties, which may be scheduled on the same date and time.

The secretariat invites Parties to carefully review the nomination procedures and applicable funding arrangements for each event before submitting nominations for participation via the Indico UN platform.

Details on using the nomination platform and steps to submit your nominations are included in the guidelines for using the Indico UN nomination platform, attached to this communication. Chapter 4 of the guidelines as well as the email to National Focal Points accompanying this message includes an access code, which should be used to access nomination forms. The system will remain open for nomination of participants requiring funding support until **24 July 2026, CET 23:59**.

In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for Climate Week-4 events as early as possible, the secretariat may not be in a position to process nominations of participants requiring funding support received after the deadline of **24 July 2026, CET 23:59**.



A. Mandated events open for nomination of Party delegates

Parties are invited, through their NFPs, to nominate participants for in-person and, where applicable, virtual attendance at the mandated events listed below.

**1. Sixth dialogue under the United Arab Emirates Just Transition Work Programme¹,
10 – 11 September 2026**

- **Nomination modality:**
 - Nominate up to **two in-person participants** per Party.
 - Nominate up to **six virtual participants** per Party.
- **Funding arrangement:**
 - Funding from the secretariat for **one nominated in-person participant** for the duration of the sixth dialogue is available to eligible Parties.
 - The funding arrangements for **funded in-person participants** will cover attendance at the sixth dialogue under the United Arab Emirates Just Transition Work Programme only. This includes round-trip air travel at the least costly available economy-class fare, daily subsistence allowance (DSA) at the United Nations rate from the official day of arrival through the last day of the sixth dialogue, and terminal expenses.
 - **In-person participants** who have been nominated as “**non-funded**”, are responsible for covering all expenses related to their attendance of the sixth dialogue under the United Arab Emirates Just Transition Work Programme.

 - Owing to limited availability of financial resources, the secretariat is not in a position to fund participants (travel and daily subsistence allowance) for the ACE workshop.
 - However, the secretariat looks forward to continuing to facilitate support for building and strengthening the skills and capacities of all appointed national ACE focal points, as well as their attendance at relevant mandated UNFCCC meetings, upon request and subject to available resources.

Therefore, if room capacity is reached, priority will be given to the participation of NGCCFPs in the event.

Annex III

Implementation Forum

The **Implementation Forum** will take place on 9 and 10 September 2026 and will feature a series of events, including Implementation labs, Impact dialogues and COP Presidency events, focused on actionable solutions, bringing together implementers and policymakers to accelerate climate action. The thematic focus of the events will be based on the six axes of the global climate action agenda⁹ ensuring alignment to the first GST outcomes, while also reflecting broader priorities relevant to implementation, including industrial decarbonization and access to finance. The Implementation Forum is a key pillar of Climate Weeks, under which Parties and non-Party stakeholders can exchange on practical implementation solutions. Convening these discussions at the Climate Weeks helps localize the Global Climate Action Agenda, highlighting region-specific initiatives while drawing on global expertise and supporting preparations towards the second GST.
