The UNFCCC secretariat would like to inform Parties and observer States that it has received a note verbal dated 30 April 2018, from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Poland indicating that the Government has decided to present the candidature of Mr. Michal Kurtyka, State Secretary, Ministry of Energy of Poland as COP 24 President.

In accordance with Article 22 of the draft rules of procedures being applied, the President of COP 24 will be elected at the commencement of the forthcoming Conference of the Parties to be held from 3 – 14 December 2018 in Katowice, Poland.
