## MESSAGE TO PARTIES AND OBSERVER STATES

**Nomination for participants to Mandated Events** 

and

#### **Information on other Events**

Climate Week 2 - Addis Ababa, Ethiopia 1 - 6 September 2025

The secretariat refers to the <u>Message to Parties</u> and observers dated 2 July 2025 regarding the second Climate Week 2025 which will be held from 1 to 6 September 2025 in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia.

In an effort to streamline the nomination process for the mandated events taking place during the Climate Week and to avoid multiple communications, the secretariat is issuing a single consolidated message to Parties for all mandated events taking place at the Climate Week which invites National Focal Points (NFPs) to nominate their delegation and also share information on other events taking place during the Climate Week.

The complete overview programme for the Climate Week in Addis Ababa is available <u>here</u>. Detailed information on each event will also be made available on the webpage of respective events.

All mandated events will be organized in accordance with their respective mandates under the Conference of Parties serving as the meeting of Parties to the Paris Agreement and of the Subsidiary Bodies.

# Nomination and registration for mandated events inviting nominations from NFPs and information on other events

Nomination procedures for each mandated event, including funding modalities, are available in the relevant section of this message below. Please carefully review the nomination procedures and funding modalities for each event before making nominations for participation via the nomination portal.

**Distribution:** To Parties and observer States through their national focal points and diplomatic missions accredited to the Federal Republic of Germany.



Parties are invited, through their NFPs, to nominate participants for in-person attendance at the mandated events listed below. Parties are also invited, through their NFPs, to nominate participants for virtual participation for mandated events, where applicable.

Nomination of representatives to mandated events and those for which funding will be provided, should be done using the <u>UN nomination Indico portal</u>. The nomination portal is now open. Parties are further encouraged to nominate individuals with expertise and experience relevant to the event for which they are nominated. The nomination portal is now open. ## 1. Fourth dialogue under the UAE Just Transition Work Programme<sup>1</sup>, 1 and 2 September

- Nominate up to **two in-person participants** per Party.
- Nominate up to six virtual participants per Party.
- Funding modality:

Owing to limited availability of financial resources, the secretariat is not in a position to fully fund participants (travel and daily subsistence allowance) for the fourth dialogue. However, the secretariat is able to provide funding limited to four days of daily subsistence allowance for one in-person participant from each eligible Party. This daily subsistence allowance can be provided to a participant who has been nominated by a Party and duly registered as a funded in-person participant to attend the sixth global dialogue and investment-focused event under the Sharm el-Sheikh mitigation ambition and implementation work programme being held during Climate Week -2 (5 -6 September 2025), or a participant who may wish to cover their cost of travel to attend the dialogue using their own funds. For the former case, travel arrangements will be coordinated by the secretariat and the cost of any ticket modification will be borne by the secretariat.

- The dialogue will be held in a hybrid format, with connection details shared with all registered participants in due time. The dialogue will also be broadcast live for those interested in following without active participation.

# 2. Sixth global dialogue and investment-focused event under the Sharm el-Sheikh mitigation ambition and implementation work programme<sup>2</sup>, 5 and 6 September

- Nominate up to **two in-person participants** per Party.
- Nominate up to six virtual participants per Party.
- Funding modality:
  - o Funding from the secretariat for two nominated in-person participants for the duration of the global dialogue and the investment-focused event is available to eligible Parties.
  - National Focal Points may consider nominating one of the funded participants attending the sixth global dialogue and investment-focused event under the Sharm el-Sheikh mitigation ambition and implementation work programme to also attend the Fourth Dialogue under the United Arab Emirates Just Transition Work Programme being held during Climate Week 2 (1 2 September 2025). In this case, the secretariat will be able to provide additional funding limited to four days of daily subsistence allowance for the one in-person participant from the eligible Party nominated for both events to enable their participation in both events.

- 3. Unlocking Article 6 for climate finance and raising ambition<sup>3</sup>, 5 and 6 September
  - Nominate one in-person participant per Party.
  - Nominate up to **two virtual participants** per Party.
  - Funding modality: Eligible Parties may receive funding from the secretariat for one nominated in-person participant to attend this event and also participate in the implementation forum (3 4 September).
  - Additional details: This two-day workshop as part of the Climate Week, will explore the catalytic role of carbon markets—especially under Article 6.4 of the Paris Agreement—in unlocking climate finance and accelerating Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC) implementation across Africa.

Bringing together governments, private sector, regional and multilateral organizations, and technical experts, the event will blend information sessions, interactive discussions, and peer learning. The workshop will be designed to build foundational knowledge, share regional experiences, and chart practical pathways for scaling up investment and participation in high-integrity carbon markets.

- In-person participation: up to two in-person Party delegates to attend all adaptation events;
- Virtual participation: open to all Party delegates;
- **Funding modality**: funding may be provided for a limited number of eligible developing country Parties. Exact modalities will be coordinated through regional groups and national focal points.

Parties are advised that this portal is the only official channel for nominating participants for the events during the Climate Week. The secretariat is not in a position to process nominations submitted by

any other method. Please note that it is imperative that a correct and unique email address be provided for each nominated participant for swift processing of nominations and initiating registration. Once a participant has been nominated for an event, they will receive an email with registration details via Indico UN. Logistical details related to travel and participation will be shared directly with registered participants.

In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the Climate Week events as early as possible, the secretariat may not be in a position to process nominations of participants requiring funding support received after the deadline of **25 July 2025**, **CEST 23:59**.

## **Implementation Forum**

The **Implementation Forum** will take place on 3 and 4 September 2025 and will feature a series of events. Over the course of the two days, the Forum will include, among others, the Climate Week Opening Ceremony; a number of events hosted by the COP 30 Presidency, including a mandated dialogue on advancing the role of local communities in the UNFCCC Process, events by the Presidency Youth Climate Champion, and dedicated sessions on climate finance. As in <u>Climate Week 1 2025</u>, a dedicated space will be created for the Implementation Labs, which will focus on thematic issues such as forests, agriculture, and carbon markets.

All participants registered for the events taking place during Climate Week 2, will be able to join the 2-day Implementation Forum. Note that registration for the forum will be open to any stakeholders, taking into consideration capacity of the venue.

Kindly note, participation in the Implementation Forum will not be separately or additionally funded. Any additional funding requirements for nominated participants to attend the implementation forum should be confirmed with the relevant event organizers.
