The United Nations and the UNFCCC secretariat disclaim all responsibility for medical, accident and travel insurance, for compensation for death or disability, for loss of or damage to personal property and for any other costs or losses that may be incurred during travel or the period of participation.

Implementation Forum

The **Implementation Forum** will take place on 9 and 10 September 2026 and will feature a series of events, including Implementation labs, Impact dialogues and COP presidency events, focused on actionable solutions, bringing together implementers and policymakers to accelerate climate action. The thematic focus of the events will be based on the six axes of the global climate action agenda¹¹ ensuring alignment to the first GST outcomes, while also reflecting broader priorities relevant to implementation, including industrial decarbonization and access to finance. The Implementation Forum is a key pillar of Climate Weeks, under which Parties and non-Party stakeholders can exchange on practical implementation solutions. Convening these discussions at the Climate Weeks helps localize the Global Climate Action Agenda, highlighting region-specific initiatives while drawing on global expertise and supporting preparations towards the second GST.
