The secretariat refers to the <u>Message to Parties and observers</u> dated 2 July 2025 regarding the <u>second Climate Week 2025</u> which will be held from 1 to 6 September 2025 in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia.

UN organizations and admitted IGOs are further encouraged to express interest of representatives with expertise and experience relevant to the event for which they are expressing interest.

UN organizations and admitted IGOs are advised that <u>UN Indico portal</u> is the only official channel for expressing interest to participate to the events during the Climate Week. The secretariat is not in a position to process expressions of interest submitted by any other method. Please note that it is imperative that a correct and unique email address be provided for each interested participant for swift processing of requests and initiating registration. Upon acceptance of an expression of interest, the once a participant has been for an event, they will receive an email with registration details via the <u>UN Indicoportal</u>.

II. Implementation Forum

The **Implementation Forum** will take place on 3 and 4 September and will feature a series of events. Over the course of the two days, the Forum will include, among others, the Climate Week Opening Ceremony; a number of events hosted by the COP 30 Presidency, including events on "Mutirão", climate action agenda and a mandated dialogue on advancing the role of local communities in the UNFCCC Process. Other sessions during the Implementation Forum will focus on climate finance and adaptation, for example the Adaptation Finance event and Public-Private dialogue on Finance. As in Climate Week 1 2025, a dedicated space will be created for the Implementation Labs, which will focus on thematic issues, such as forests, agriculture, sustainable cities, energy transition and access, and carbon markets.
