MESSAGE TO PARTIES AND OBSERVER STATES

Expert Dialogue on Mountains and Climate Change 5 June 2024

I am pleased to inform Parties and observer States to the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement that the **Expert Dialogue on Mountains and Climate Change** referred to in paragraph 181 of decision 1/CMA.5 will be held during the sixtieth session of the Subsidiary Bodies (SBs 60) in Bonn, Germany, on 5 June 2024 from 10:00 to 13:00 and from 15:00 to 18:00 (CEST).

Decision 1/CMA.5 requested the Chair of the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) to hold an expert dialogue on mountains and climate change at its sixtieth session.

The Expert Dialogue on Mountains and Climate Change is open to all SB 60 registered participants and will be held under the guidance of the Chair of the SBSTA. The dialogue will provide a unique opportunity to convene relevant experts and stakeholders with the aim of:

- Enhancing understanding of climate change impacts on mountains and downstream communities, including in a transboundary context;
- Showcasing solutions contributing to the resilience of mountain ecosystems to climate change;
- Discussing ways to accelerate climate action at scale and at all levels, contributing to the resilience of mountain ecosystems, including in countries with fragile mountain ecosystems.

Further details regarding the dialogue will be made available on the dedicated event webpage once they become available.
