Discussion Topic First dialogue under the United Arab Emirates Just Transition Work Programme in 2024

As the chairs of the SBSTA and the SBI, we have been tasked by <u>decision 3/CMA.5</u>, <u>paras. 3-4</u> with guiding the secretariat in organizing at least two dialogues this year, with one to be held prior to the first regular sessions of the subsidiary bodies with their sixtieth sessions (June 2024), and one prior to the second regular sessions of the subsidiary bodies, starting with their sixty-first sessions (November 2024), and that such dialogues should be conducted in hybrid format to allow both in-person and virtual participation. Paragraph 5 of decision 3/CMA 5 also requires us to decide on the topics to be discussed under the dialogues this year, taking into consideration the submissions from Parties, observers and other non-Party stakeholders.

We are pleased to communicate to Parties and observer organizations that the first dialogue under the work programme in 2024 will focus on: "Just Transition pathways to achieving the goals of the Paris Agreement through NDCs, NAPs and LT-LEDs".

We would like to encourage Parties, observers and other non-Party stakeholders to submit via the <u>submission portal</u> views on opportunities, best practices, actionable solutions, challenges and barriers relevant to the topic of the first dialogue as early as possible, and no later than four weeks before the dialogue², in order for us to share the agenda well in advance³.

Information on further details and participation by Parties, observers and other non-Party stakeholders on the global dialogues will be communicated through the proper channels as it becomes available.
