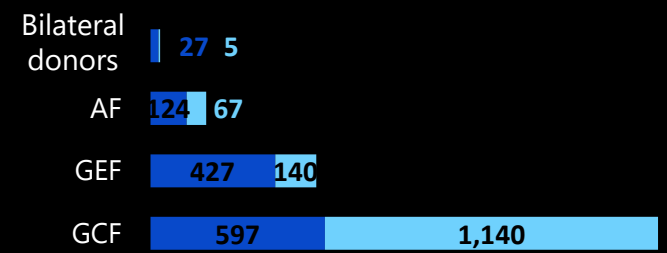

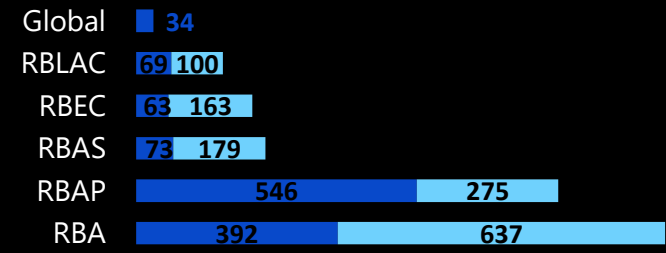

## Mainstreaming adaptation through National Adaptation Plans

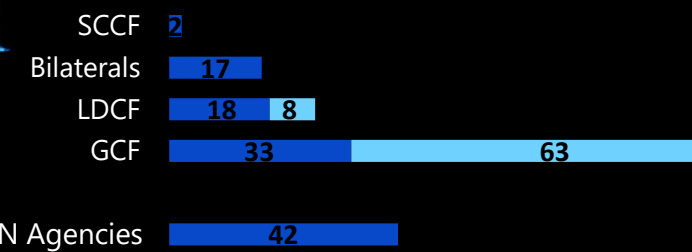

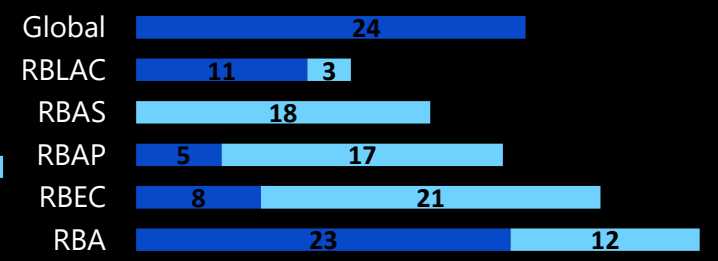

FUNDS BY REGION (\$ Million)

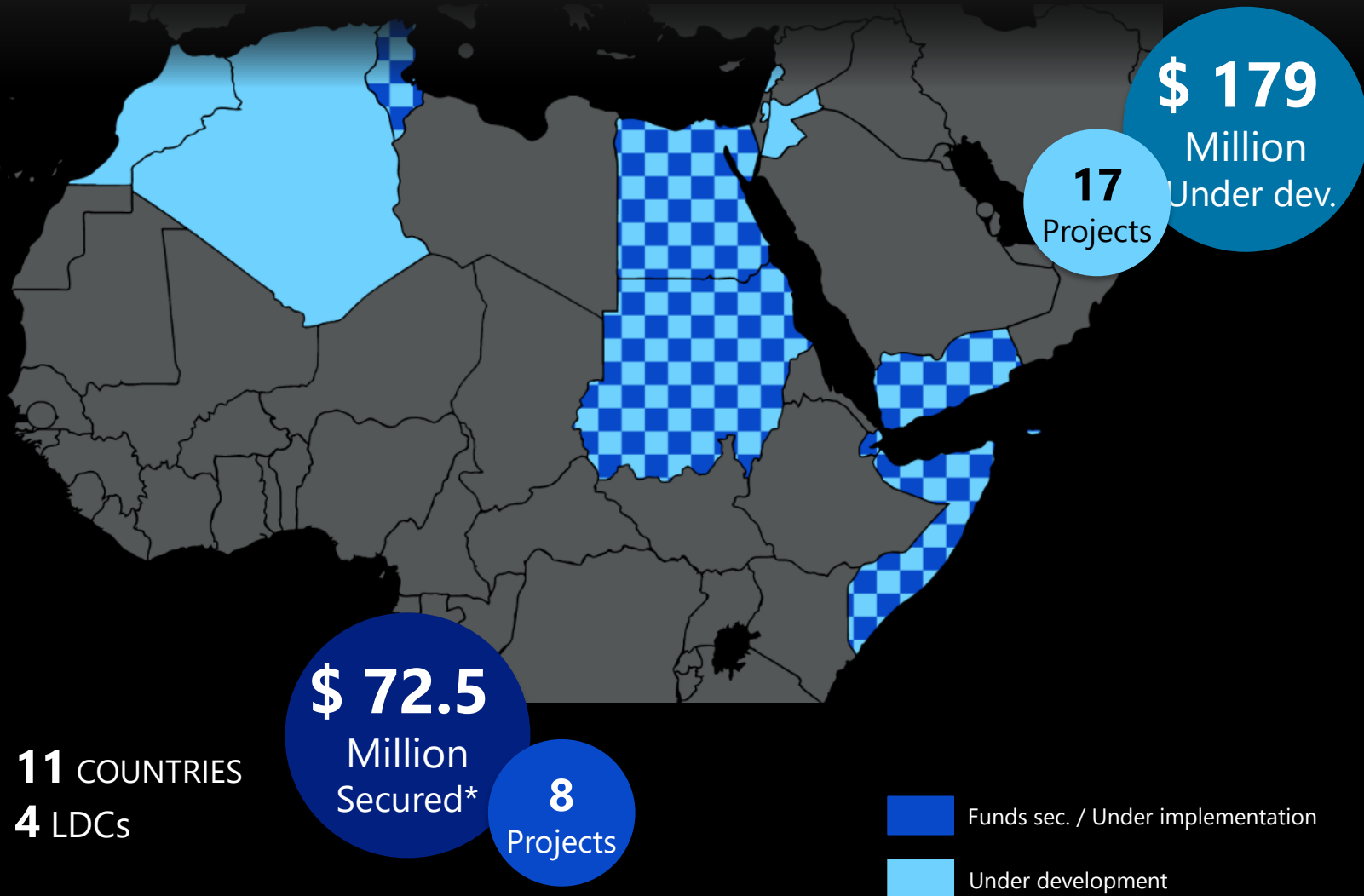

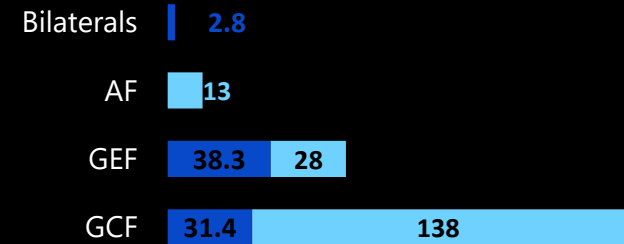

## *Integrated policy and planning for climate-resilient, sustainable development*



### **Cross-sectoral resilient livelihoods**

- 3 countries
- 3 projects
- \$ 19 million under implementation
- 13 AWS constructed
- 18.3 million beneficiaries

### **Fostering resilience for food security**

- 1 countries
- 2 projects
- \$ 11 million under implementation
- 183,500 small-holder farmers using climate resilient agricultural practices
- 230 ha of agricultural land protected



### **Ecosystem-based adaptation**

- 4 countries
- 4 projects
- \$ 50 million under implementation
- 130,700 million ha of land area protected
- 1,600 ha of land area restored/reforested

### **Climate resilient water resource and coastal management**

- 4 countries
- 4 projects
- \$ 50 million under implementation
- 183,500 people with increased access to drinking water
- 100+ km of coastline protected

## Enhancing resilience and adaptive capacity of vulnerable communities and ecosystems by integrating climate risks in natural resources management and disaster preparedness



- **19,524 households with enhanced livelihoods** through access to water, improved ecosystem services and reforestation (exceeded target by 170 percent)



- **Initiated program for a new Master's degree** on climate and environment at Amoud University, with 30 students enrolled in its first year



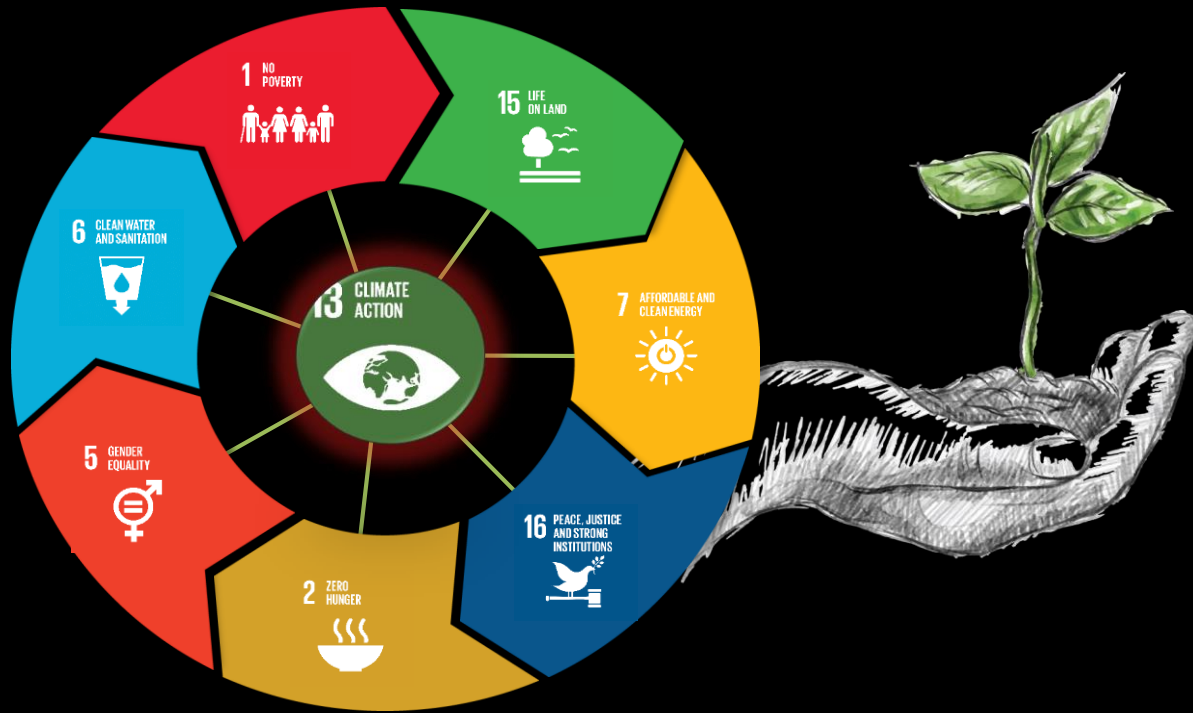
- **Rehabilitated 11 boreholes**, benefitting up to 45,000 people

# SDG Climate Facility Project: Climate Action for Human Security



- Focused on nexus between climate action and human security
- **Objective:** Enhance capacity of regional, national and local institutions to effectively integrate climate change consideration into development and crisis prevention/recovery interventions and policies, including support to scale-up climate finance for innovative local solutions
- **Resilience grants:** Egypt, Iraq, Yemen, Syria/Jordan/Lebanon, Occupied Palestinian Territories, Tunisia



## BMZ, IDF and UNDP: Tripartite Agreement 2020-2025

### 20 Countries, two components

- ✓ **Inclusive Insurance:** Community and vulnerability focus; mutuals and cooperatives.
- ✓ **Risk Financing and Development:** Sovereign risk financing; leveraging US\$5 billion private sector capital; Integration of industry expertise into development.

### Cross-cutting activities

- ✓ Market Development: Legislation, regulation, institutions;
- ✓ Research, evidence, impact measurement, knowledge.

### Mechanics

- ✓ EUR20 million first tranche, 2020 to 2023
- ✓ Tied to InsuResilience target of 500 million additional beneficiaries of climate risk insurance by 2025.



**UNDP's Climate Promise:** To support 100 countries enhance their Nationally Determined Contributions by 2020, with demonstrated increase in ambition

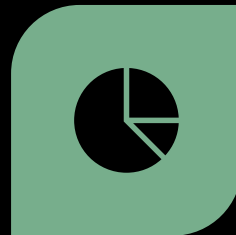

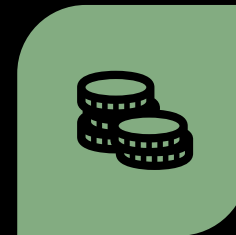
