PILOTING A METHODOLOGY WITH MULTI-STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT

Convening stakeholder dialogues

- Bringing together stakeholders who may not have been convened before
- Using the opportunity to articulate gender and climate interlinkages and policy/program frameworks specific to country (led by NGCCFP)
- Presenting the history of gender within the UNFCCC and the NGCCFP role
- Host a dialogue on opportunities, directions, and strategic entry points for the NGCCFP role, with reference to a ToR in development
- Establish momentum for continued communication and potential coordination among this group of stakeholders

EMERGING INSIGHTS AND ENABLING FACTORS

Emerging Insights

- Institutional arrangements matter.
- The NGCCFP role exists outside of one individual.
- Party priorities shape the Terms of Reference.
- Terms of Reference are not workplans.

Enabling Factors

- Party support and enthusiasm for elaborating the role
- NGCCFP understanding of the UNFCCC and potential activities/responsibilities to support implementation of the Paris Agreement and GAP
- Institutional landscape that values gender-responsive planning & policymaking
