



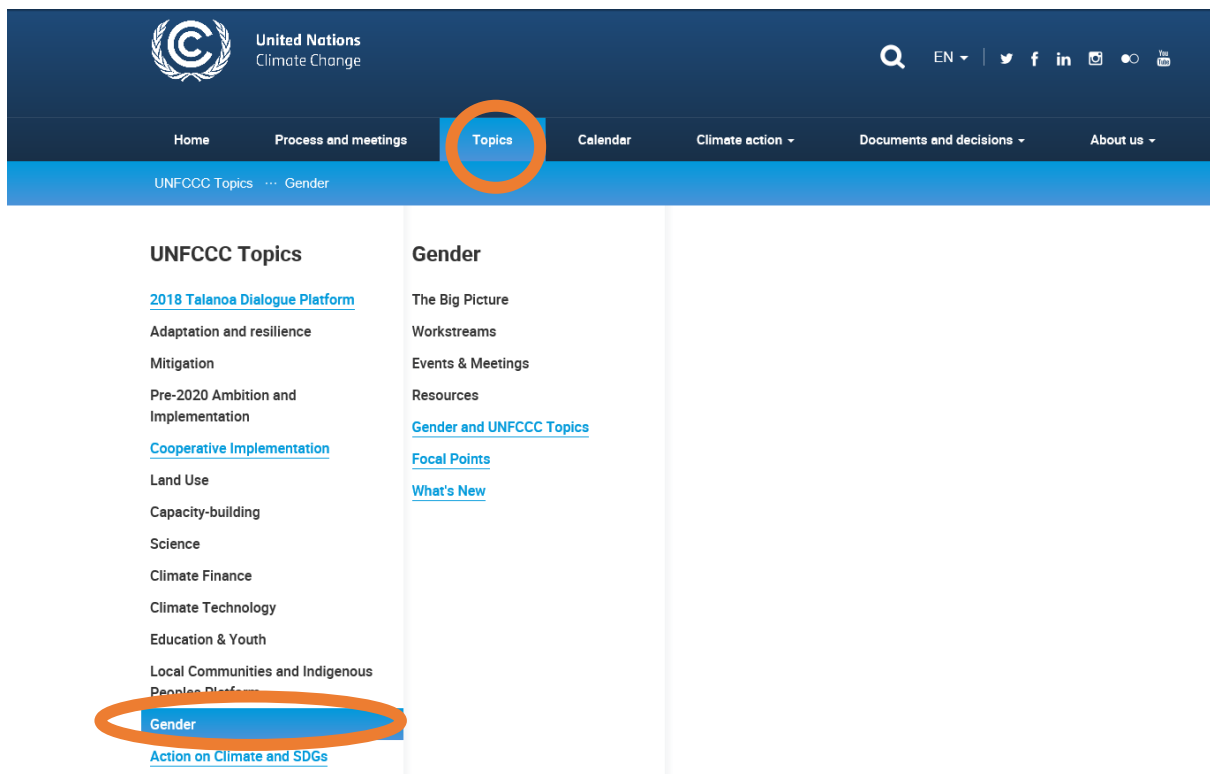

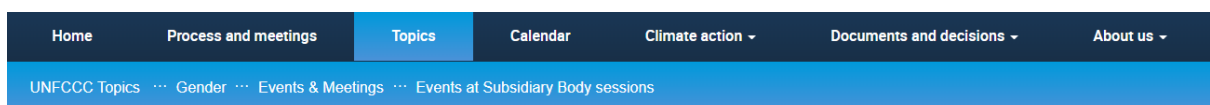
Gender website navigation guide

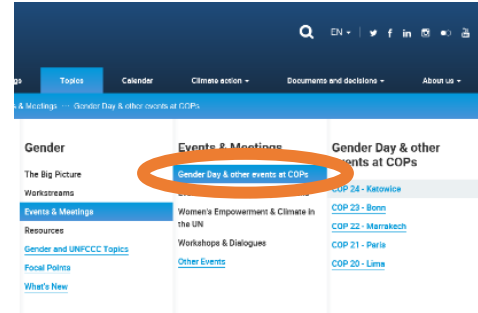

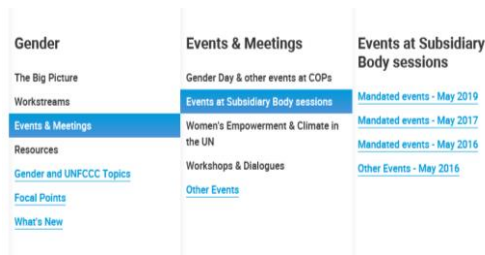
