GlaSS - Proposed Structure of a draft Decision for CMA5 - Norway:

Norway finds that the all three proposals for the structure of a CMA decisions presented by the G77+China, US and the EU has merits. We would like to propose a structure that builds on the three proposals bringing clear recommendations on the GGA work programme in line with its mandate from CMA 3 and clearly establishing the framework as decided at CMA 4.

- 1. **Preambular text** (incl. need to strengthen adaptation action and support in achieving the GGA)
- 2. **Capturing progress and provide recommendations on** the Glasgow Sharm el-Sheikh work programme, ref. para 17 of 7/CMA.3 which could be structured as follows:
 - a. Recommendations on the understanding of the GGA
 - b. Recommendations linked to elements of the adaptation cycle (impact, vulnerability and risk assessment, planning, implementation, and M&E)
 - c. Recommendations on international cooperation
 - d. Recommendations on support, including financial support for developing countries

3. Establishment of the GGA framework

- a. The framework (in line with the dimensions, themes and cross cutting issues in 3/CMA.4 p.10, and enabling conditions: institutions, coordination, reporting instruments etc. needed to fulfil the purpose)
- b. Input to implementation of the Framework (incl. from Parties, organisations etc. inside and outside of the PA)

4. Follow-up work

- The modalities and institutions, including the necessary cooperation, coordination, and coherence needed, that will contribute to the overall success of the Framework
- b. Arrangements for monitoring progress of the framework, including reporting instruments
- c. Review framework before GST2 (ref. 3/CMA.4 p.11)
