### Sixteenth meeting of the Adaptation Committee Bonn, Germany 9–12 September 2019

Pursuant to decisions 1/CP.16 and 2/CP.17, I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that the sixteenth meeting of the Adaptation Committee will take place at the United Nations Campus in Bonn, Germany, from 9 to 12 September 2019.

In accordance with the modalities and procedures adopted by decision 2/CP.17, the meeting of the Adaptation Committee will be open to admitted observer organizations, except where otherwise decided by the Adaptation Committee. Given space limitations, participation will be limited to two representatives for each of the nine constituencies.

Representatives from NGOs nominated by the Constituency Focal Point must register for the meeting using the Observer Registration Form for NGOs, which is sent to Constituency Focal Points.

The deadline for registration as an observer is **Friday, 16 August 2019**. In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, please be advised that the secretariat may not be in a position to process observer registrations received after this deadline.
