Nineteenth meeting of the Adaptation Committee

16–19 March 2021
Virtual meeting

Pursuant to decisions 1/CP.16 and 2/CP.17, I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that the nineteenth meeting of the Adaptation Committee will take place as a virtual meeting from 16 to 19 March 2021.¹

In accordance with the modalities and procedures adopted by decision 2/CP.17, the meeting of the Adaptation Committee will be open to admitted observer organizations, except where otherwise decided by the Adaptation Committee. Participation will be limited to two representatives for each of the nine constituencies.

Representatives from NGOs nominated by the Constituency Focal Point must register for the meeting using the Observer Registration Form for NGOs, which is sent to Constituency Focal Points.

The deadline for registration as an observer is **Monday, 1 March 2021**. In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, please be advised that the secretariat may not be able to process observer registrations received after this deadline.
