The 12th meeting of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures

Pursuant to decisions 13/CP.28, 4/CMP.18 and 19/CMA.5, I am pleased to inform Parties and observer States to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement that the 12th meeting of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures (KCI) is planned to take place in Bonn, Germany, from 12 to 13 June 2025.

In accordance with the modalities adopted by decisions 13/CP.28, 4/CMP.18 and 19/CMA.5, the meeting of the KCI will be open to attendance as observers by Parties and accredited observer organizations, unless otherwise decided by the KCI.

Constituency focal points are invited to submit their list of nominations via cool@unfccc.int by **Friday, 11 April 2025, at the latest**. In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, please be advised that the secretariat may not be able to process observer registrations received after this deadline.
