## High-level Ministerial Dialogues on the New Collective Quantified Goal on Climate Finance

## Sharm El-Sheikh, Arab Republic of Egypt

I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that the **first high-level ministerial dialogue on the new collective quantified goal on climate finance** will take place on **Wednesday**, **09 November 2022 from 15:00 to 18:00** in conference premises in Sharm El-Sheikh, Arab Republic of Egypt (Egypt).

The Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement (CMA), at its third session, decided to convene high-level ministerial dialogues on climate finance starting in 2022 and ending in 2024, ensuring effective political engagement and open, meaningful, and robust discussion. The high-level ministerial dialogue will be informed by the reports on the technical expert dialogues, submissions by Parties and non-Party stakeholders on the new collective quantified goals, and the technical paper prepared by the UNFCCC secretariat on the submissions.

This dialogue aims to provide guidance on the further direction of the ad hoc work programme the following year. The CMA 4 President will prepare a summary of the deliberations at the high-level ministerial dialogue, including recommendations, for consideration by CMA 4.

The dialogue will have a webcast. Representatives of admitted NGOs nominated by constituency focal points must register for the ministerial dialogue using the observer registration form for NGOs, which has been sent to constituency focal points. Kindly note that, owing to the limited capacity of the venue, **two representatives per constituency** at the head of organization level, will be permitted to participate in person. Once the constituency focal points have confirmed their nominations, the registration forms should be emailed to <u>cool@unfccc.int</u> no later than 7 November 2022.

**Distribution:** To constituency focal points of non-governmental organizations admitted as observers by the Conference of the Parties.
