The 14th meeting of the Executive Committee of the Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage associated with Climate Change Impacts

7–24 September 2021

I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted observer non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that the 14th meeting of the Executive Committee of the Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage associated with Climate Change Impacts will take place between 7 and 24 September 2021 (discontinuously, in approximately eight live sessions of two hours each). Owing to travel restrictions due to the COVID-19 pandemic, it will be held in a virtual format.

The meeting will be open to attendance by admitted observer organizations in accordance with decision 2/CP.20, paragraph 14.

Observer nominations should be communicated to the secretariat by constituency focal points. Upon nomination, participants must register via the observer registration form for NGOs, which can be obtained from their focal points. Upon receiving the completed registration forms, constituency focal points should confirm the nominations and forward the forms to the secretariat by email (cool@unfccc.int).

The deadline for registration as an observer at the meeting is **Friday**, **27 August 2021**. In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, registrations received after this date may not be processed.
