5-8 April 2022

I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations that the 15th meeting of the Executive Committee of the Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage associated with Climate Change Impacts will take place in Bonn from 5 to 8 April 2022. Owing to travel restrictions due to the COVID-19 pandemic, virtual participation will be possible.

The meeting will be open to attendance by admitted observer organizations in accordance with decision 2/CP.20, paragraph 14.

Observer nominations should be communicated to the secretariat by constituency focal points. Upon receiving the completed registration forms, constituency focal points should confirm the nominations and email the forms to cool@unfccc.int by **Friday, 11 March 2022**.

In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, registrations received after this date may not be processed.
