### **Fourth meeting of the Facilitative Working Group of the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform**

**14–17 December 2020**

I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that the **fourth meeting of the Facilitative Working Group of the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform** will take place from 14 to 17 December 2020. Owing to current travel restrictions resulting from the COVID-19 virus, the meeting will be held in a virtual format.

The meeting will be open to observers in accordance with the modalities and procedures adopted by decision 2/CP.24. The Facilitative Working Group strives for inclusiveness in its work.

Representatives who would like to attend must be nominated by the Constituency Focal Point. The deadline for the Constituency Focal Points to submit registration is **Friday, 4 December 2020**. In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, observer registrations received after this deadline may not be processed.

Once nominated by the constituency focal point, representatives must register for the meeting using the Observer Registration Form for NGOs, which can be obtained from the constituency focal points. The completed form should be returned to the focal point. Upon receiving the registration form, the constituency focal points should confirm the nomination(s) and forward the registration form to the secretariat at [cool@unfccc.int](mailto:cool@unfccc.int).
