Pacific regional gathering under the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform

16-20 October 2023, Queensland, Australia

I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs) to the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement that the **Pacific regional gathering under the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform** (LCIPP) will take place in Queensland, Australia from 16 to 20 October 2023.

The second three-year LCIPP workplan calls for at least two regional or biregional gatherings to be organized per year in 2022–2023 to bring together Indigenous Peoples, local communities, Parties and other stakeholders from the respective region(s) to exchange experience and good practices in relation to addressing climate change and building climate resilience.

Interested representatives from the Pacific region, nominated by constituency focal points, must register using the online registration form, which will be communicated to the nominated participants. Constituency focal points are requested to submit their nomination list no later than **Monday, 18 September 2023** via <u>cool@unfccc.int</u>. In view of the need to coordinate logistical arrangements, registrations received after this deadline may not be processed.

Details of the LCIPP gathering for the Pacific region will be made available on the <u>LCIPP</u> web portal in due course. Further details will also be communicated directly to registered participants.
