Pacific regional gathering under the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform

16–20 October 2023, Queensland, Australia

I am pleased to notify United Nations organizations and admitted intergovernmental organizations to the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement that the **Pacific regional gathering under the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform (LCIPP)** will take place in Queensland, Australia from 16 to 20 October 2023.

The second three-year LCIPP workplan calls for at least two regional or biregional gatherings to be organized per year in 2022–2023 to bring together Indigenous Peoples, local communities, Parties and other stakeholders from the respective region(s) to exchange experience and good practices in relation to addressing climate change and building climate resilience.

Interested representatives of United Nations organizations and admitted intergovernmental organizations from the Pacific region are requested to register to participate in the gathering by completing the [online registration form](#). For registrations to be considered, focal points are requested to confirm the name of their representative(s) by email to LCIPP@unfccc.int. The deadline for registrations is **Monday, 25 September 2023**. In view of the need to coordinate logistical arrangements, registrations received after this deadline may not be processed.
