## The 21<sup>st</sup> meeting of the Technology Executive Committee

## 17-20 November 2020

Pursuant to the rules of procedure of the Technology Executive Committee, as contained in annex II to decision 4/CP.17, I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that the 21<sup>st</sup> meeting of the Technology Executive Committee will take place from 17 to 20 November 2020. Owing to travel restrictions due to the COVID-19 pandemic, it will be held as a virtual meeting, taking place from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. Central European Time each day.

The meeting will be open to admitted observer organizations in accordance with the abovementioned decision. Observer nominations should be communicated to the secretariat by constituency focal points. Upon nomination, representatives must register via the observer registration form for NGOs, which can be obtained from their focal points.

Upon receiving the registration forms, the constituency focal points should confirm the nominations and forward the registration forms to the secretariat at <u>cool@unfccc.int</u> by no later than **Friday, 23 October 2020**, 5 p.m. Central European Time.

In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, observer registrations for NGOs received after this deadline may not be processed.
