Eighteenth meeting of the Technology Executive Committee 25 – 27 March 2019

Pursuant to the rules of procedure of the Technology Executive Committee (TEC), as contained in annex II to decision 4/CP.17, I am pleased to notify Parties and observer States to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) that the 18th meeting of the TEC will take place from 25 to 27 March 2019 at "UN City Campus" in Copenhagen, Denmark. Please note that the TEC meeting is organized in conjunction with the 13th meeting of the Advisory Board of the Climate Technology Centre and Network (CTCN), with an all-day TEC-CTCN joint session scheduled on Wednesday, 27 March.

In accordance with the above-mentioned decision, the meeting will be open to observers. Such observers include Parties, observer States and UNFCCC admitted organizations.
