Thirty-seventh Meeting of the Standing Committee on Finance

11–13 June 2025 Bonn, Germany

I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that the thirty-seventh meeting of the Standing Committee on Finance (SCF 37) will take place from **11 to 13 June 2025** in Bonn, Germany. On 11 June 2025, the SCF will convene a technical expert session on available information, data, sources and approaches to monitor the new collective quantified goal on climate finance.

The provisional agenda for SCF 37, webcast link and any additional documents will be uploaded to the <u>SCF documents web page</u> prior to the meeting.

NGO observer nominations should be communicated to the secretariat by Constituency Focal Points. Representatives of admitted NGOs nominated by Constituency Focal Points must register using the online registration form, which will be communicated to the nominated participants. Kindly note that, owing to the limited capacity of the venue, two representatives per NGO constituency will be allocated to participate in person. Constituency Focal Points are requested to submit their nominations no later than **Monday**, **26 May 2025** via cool@unfccc.int.

Additional observers may participate virtually. The deadline for registration for virtual participation through the Constituency Focal Points is **4 June 2025**.

Further details relevant to both in-person and virtual participation in the meeting will be communicated directly to the registered participants. In view of the need to confirm arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, registrations received after the above-mentioned deadlines may not be processed. The meeting will also be broadcast live for those who cannot be nominated for either one of the two modalities above so that they can follow the meeting. The webcast link will be made available on the <u>SCF web page</u>.
