## **WWF Press Briefing: Opportunities to Accelerate Climate Action Now**

The next three years are crucial accelerating climate action and in order to fulfill the Paris Agreement's ambitious temperature goals. During the opening of COP23 today, developing countries stressed the need to prioritize pre-2020 action along with addressing revisions of national targets, covering the period 2020 -2030.
