









Global Climate Action High-Level Event (opening): Towards a Turning Point for Climate Action

The Global Climate Action (GCA) High-Level Event (opening) will convene world leaders, multi-sectoral and non-State actors on the second day of the World Climate Action Summit to open the Action Agenda at COP 28. With the thematic program of COP 28 aimed at uniting a diverse range of stakeholders around scalable solutions for enhancing resilience, addressing the adaptation gap, mobilizing finance, protecting nature and limiting global warming to 1.5 degrees. This is an opportunity to rise to the occasion and ensure a better, healthier, and just future for generations to come.

As world leaders convene at COP 28 to address collective gaps in global climate action to date as part of the Global Stocktake process, a groundswell of businesses, cities and regions, civil society organizations, youth and indigenous peoples offer real-economy solutions for a strong response to the Global Stocktake. High-Level Champions and Marrakech Partnership offer the Climate Action Pathways, the 2030 Breakthroughs, the Breakthrough Agenda, the Sharm El-Sheikh Adaptation Agenda, the Race to Resilience and the Race to Zero campaigns as part of a framework readily available to Parties and non-Party stakeholders to accelerate and track progress on actions and commitments, in line with science-aligned pathways to 2030. The Action Agenda at COP28 highlights the solutions that must be scaled on this seven year sprint to address the climate crisis.
