In accordance with the modalities and procedures adopted by decision 15/CP.18, the workshop will be open to admitted observer organizations. Given space limitations, participation will be limited to **two representatives per constituency.**

Representatives from admitted NGOs nominated by the Constituency Focal Points must register for the meeting using the Observer Registration Form for NGOs, which is sent to Constituency Focal Points. Once the Constituency Focal Points confirm the nomination(s), they should forward the registration form to the secretariat using the following email address:

The deadline for registration as an observer is **Monday**, 24th September 2018 in view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, please be advised that the secretariat may not be in a position to process observer registration forms for NGOs received after this deadline.
