



Open call for submissions
of information on capacity-building activities undertaken to be uploaded on the
capacity-building portal and corresponding complementary resources

Pursuant to decision [16/CP.22](#), paragraph 9, United Nations agencies, multilateral organizations and relevant admitted observer organizations engaged in providing capacity-building support to developing countries are invited to submit information to be uploaded on the [capacity-building portal](#). Such information should be related to capacity-building activities with a view to building and/or enhancing the capacity of developing countries to implement the Climate Change [Convention](#), the [Kyoto Protocol](#) and the [Paris Agreement](#).

The capacity-building portal is a digital platform and work in progress, which has been initiated to contribute and monitor the progress on the implementation of the framework for capacity-building actions in developing countries, enshrined in decision [2/CP.7](#). Through its interactive world map, it is possible to access, retrieve and download capacity-building related information submitted since 2008 by United Nations organizations, its specialized agencies and related institutions. Since 2016 the portal features also information on capacity-building activities undertaken by admitted observer organizations, following the provisions contained in decision 16/CP.22.

In 2017 and based on the requests of Party and non-Party stakeholders to present additional information related to capacity-building activities, [webpages](#), [YouTube channel](#) and a [Facebook page](#) have been added to the portal and are intended to complement the information contained therein. Organizations engaged in providing capacity-building support to developing countries are encouraged to send information to pccb@unfccc.int for integrating their information into the webpages and/or Facebook page, as appropriate.

As a repository of information on the delivery of capacity-building actions the capacity-building portal and its complementary resources are relevant to contribute to the work of the Paris Committee on Capacity-building when implementing its mandates and its [rolling workplan](#).
