Doha Work Programme intermediate review

Findings

- Progress has been made by Parties and other relevant stakeholders in planning, coordinating and implementing the six elements of ACE
- Although all Parties reported that they are currently implementing ACE activities, those are not always embedded in their broader mitigation and adaptation actions
- Some Parties reported that they developed a national strategy on ACE in a multisectoral, multi-stakeholder and participatory process
- Parties have increasingly reported on elements covered by ACE in their national communications



Doha Work Programme intermediate review

Recommendations

- ACE should be guided by a country-driven, holistic and systematic approach
- Strengthening the existing skills and capacity of the ACE national focal points
- Establishing multi-stakeholder partnerships
- Fostering cooperation and cross-sectoral coordination among ministries
- Strengthening international cooperation to scale up action

- Empower every person to take climate action and to be a part of the solution
- Promote sustainable lifestyles and patterns of consumption and production
- Foster low-emission and climate resilient development
