# **PAICC- Legal framework**

- Article 15 of the Paris Agreement
- Modalities and procedures for the effective operation of the committee to facilitate implementation and promote compliance referred to in Article 15, paragraph 2, of the Paris Agreement (Decision 20/CMA.1)
- Rules of procedure of the committee to facilitate implementation and promote compliance referred to in Article 15, paragraph 2, of the Paris Agreement (Decision 24/CMA.4)



### Role of PAICC

- Article 15 of the Paris Agreement
- ✓ A Committee to facilitate implementation of and promote compliance with the provisions of the Paris Agreement
- ✓ A Committee that is expert-based and facilitative in nature and pays particular attention
  to the respective national capabilities and circumstances of Parties
- ✓ A Committee that functions in a manner that is transparent, non-adversarial and non-punitive
- Decision 20/CMA.1, Annex, paragraph 4
- ✓ Avoid duplication of effort, shall not function as an enforcement or dispute settlement mechanism, not impose sanctions or penalties, shall respect national sovereignty.




### PAICC – Membership

- The Committee consists of 12 Members and 12 Alternate Members, who are elected by the Conference of Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement (CMA) on the basis of equitable geographical representation and taking into account the goal of gender balance
- 2 Members each from the five regional groups of the United Nations and 1 Member each from the small island developing States (SIDS) and the least developed countries (LDCs)
- The Members and Alternate Members of the Committee serve in their individual capacity, for a term of 3 years with the possibility of re-election for one more term

# **PAICC- Initiation by the Committee**

Decision 20/CMA.1, paragraph 22 (a).

The Committee:

- (a) Will initiate the consideration of issues in cases where a Party has not.
- (i) Communicated or maintained a nationally determined contribution under Article 4 of the Paris Agreement, based on the most up-to-date status of communication in the public registry referred to in Article 4, paragraph 12, of the Paris Agreement;
- (ii) Submitted a mandatory report or communication of information under Article 13, paragraphs 7 and 9, or Article 9, paragraph 7, of the Paris Agreement;
- (iii) Participated in the **facilitative**, **multilateral consideration of progress**, based on information provided by the secretariat;
- (iv) Submitted a mandatory communication of information under Article 9, paragraph 5, of the Paris Agreement.



# PAICC –Initiation by the Committee with the consent of the Party

Decision 20/CMA.1, paragraph 22 (b).

The Committee:

(b)May, with the consent of the Party concerned, engage in a facilitative consideration of issues in cases of significant and persistent inconsistencies of the information submitted by a Party pursuant to Article 13, paragraphs 7 and 9, of the Paris Agreement with the modalities, procedures and guidelines referred to in Article 13, paragraph 13, of the Paris Agreement. This consideration will be based on the recommendations made in the final technical expert review reports, prepared under Article 13, paragraphs 11 and 12, of the Agreement, together with any written comments provided by the Party during the review. (...)



# PAICC –Initiation by the Committee with the consent of the Party

Decision 5/CMA.3, paragraph 40.

CMA:

40. Invites the committee to facilitate implementation and promote compliance referred to in Article 15, paragraph 2, of the Paris Agreement to liaise with lead reviewers, as needed, when identifying cases of significant and persistent inconsistencies referred to in decision 20/CMA.1, annex paragraph 22 (b)



### **PAICC** – Measures

The Committee shall take appropriate measures, which may include:

- 1. Engage in a **dialogue** with the Party to share information, identify challenges and recommend solutions (Decision 20/CMA.1, Annex, para 30 a)
- 2. **Assist the Party in engaging with support bodies** and arrangements and **make recommendations** to the Party (and communicate those to the support bodies/arrangements) (para 30 b and c)
- 3. Recommend development of an action plan (30 d)
- 4. **Issue findings of fact** in relation to specific matters listed in para 22 a (para 30 e)



### **PAICC** –Systemic issues

- ➤ Identification of **systemic issues** (Decision 20/CMA.1, paras 32-34), either:
  - Upon request from CMA to examine systemic issues, or
  - By the Committee itself (based on its own information)
- > Recommendations to the CMA
- ➤ Systemic issues not related to individual Parties



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
