## Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

- 1. The SBI welcomed the interim report on the effectiveness and adequacy of the support provided to the Technology Mechanism in supporting the implementation of the Paris Agreement on matters relating to technology development and transfer, prepared by the secretariat in response to decision 17/CMA.3, and noted the preliminary findings therein.
- 2. The SBI also noted that the outcomes of the first periodic assessment should guide improved effectiveness and enhanced support to the Technology Mechanism in supporting the implementation of the Paris Agreement, as guided by the technology framework, in accordance with decision 16/CMA.1.
- 3. The SBI requested the secretariat to consider Parties' deliberations at this session in preparing the final report on the effectiveness and adequacy of the support provided to the Technology Mechanism in supporting the implementation of the Paris Agreement on matters relating to technology development and transfer for consideration at SBI 57 (November 2022).
- 4. The SBI noted that the deliberations referred to in paragraph 3 above included elements relating to structuring quantitative and qualitative information, successes and challenges pertaining to the effectiveness and adequacy of the support provided to the Technology Mechanism, evolution and changes in the work undertaken by the CTCN and the TEC, sources of support provided to the Technology Mechanism and responses of the Technology Mechanism to guidance from Parties.
- 5. The SBI requested the secretariat, in preparing the final report referred to in paragraph 3 above, to continue to consult relevant stakeholders on ways to enhance the effectiveness and adequacy of the support provided to the Technology Mechanism in supporting the implementation of the Paris Agreement.
- 6. The SBI looks forward to receiving the final report referred to in paragraph 3 above, noting that it will also serve as an input to the global stocktake referred to in Article 14 of the Paris Agreement, in accordance with decision 16/CMA.1.
