Informal note by the co-facilitators

This note is our attempt to informally summarize the views expressed by Parties on these agenda items during the relevant informal consultations. It has been prepared under our own responsibility, is not exhaustive and has no formal status. It is not intended to prejudice any further work that Parties may wish to undertake or prevent Parties from expressing other views in the future.

Parties engaged constructively in the discussions and expressed a range of views and ideas on how to address the provision of financial and technical support to developing country Parties for reporting and capacity-building under the enhanced transparency framework under the Paris Agreement.

Parties and groups of Parties expressed several views and ideas, including the following:

1. Underscoring the importance of the provision of adequate, predictable and timely support to developing country Parties, in particular the least developed countries and small island developing States, for building their institutional and technical capacity for implementing the enhanced transparency framework in accordance with Article 13 of the Paris Agreement.
2. Recognizing the challenges developing country Parties face to implement the enhanced transparency framework, including:
 - Identifying needs and capacity gaps;
 - Establishing sustainable institutional arrangements;
 - Enhancing national technical capacity.
3. Acknowledging the important roles of the Global Environment Facility and the Consultative Group of Experts in provision of support to developing country Parties and requesting them to take into consideration the challenges mentioned above when carrying out their responsibilities.
4. Recognizing developing country Parties' need for enhanced support via various sources and channels, including the Global Environment Facility, for implementing the enhanced transparency framework.
5. Underlining the need for further work to develop specific ideas regarding the support required to address those challenges and build the transparency-related capacity of developing country Parties to implement the enhanced transparency framework.
