Launch online training 'Introduction to climate change and human rights'



Completing an activity started under its previous workplan, that got delayed due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the PCCB will launch an online training 'Introduction to climate change and human rights' on 2 June 2021, in conjunction with the 10th Durban Forum on capacity-building. The course was jointly developed with the United Nations Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights and the UNFCCC secretariat, and supported by the German Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development. Targeted at the general public, the course will be hosted on the One UN Climate Change Learning Partnership (UN CC:Learn) platform.
