## Development and transfer of technologies and implementation of the Technology Mechanism Poznan strategic programme on technology transfer

### Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) welcomed the information on progress in implementing the Poznan strategic programme on technology transfer contained in the report of the Global Environment Facility (GEF) to the Conference of the Parties at its twenty-seventh session.<sup>1</sup>
2. The SBI also welcomed the information note with updated information on the status and successes of, challenges in and lessons learned from projects undertaken through the regional climate technology transfer and finance centres<sup>2</sup> and encouraged the Climate Technology Centre and Network (CTCN) and GEF to consider relevant lessons learned when carrying out their activities.
3. The SBI noted the strong linkages between the regional climate technology transfer and finance centres and relevant regional networks, which have contributed to knowledge-sharing, the leveraging of investment in climate projects and the mainstreaming of climate technologies in national policies and strategies, and invited the CTCN to collaborate with the regional centres.
4. The SBI welcomed the inclusion of considerations in its workplan for 2023 – 2027, on how developing countries can be supported in updating their TNAs and implementing their technology actions plans and TNA outcomes.
5. The SBI also welcomed the continued support provided by the GEF to developing countries, including 17 least developed countries (LDCs) and small island developing States (SIDS), for undertaking their TNAs under the fourth TNA project.<sup>3</sup>
6. The SBI invited the LDCs and SIDS that have not yet undertaken a TNA and wish to do so to obtain support for it under the eighth replenishment of the GEF and noted that other developing countries can make use of their national allocation under the System for Transparent Allocation of Resources to prepare or update their TNA or implement their technology action plan and TNA outcomes.
7. The SBI agreed to conclude its consideration of this matter.
