RIO CONVENTIONS

Climate change, desertification and biodiversity loss are strongly interrelated and pose existential challenges to humanity. In response to these challenges, Panama, as a leading green and blue country, presents its **Nature Pledge**, a strategic framework that maximizes synergies among the three Rio Conventions to which the country has been a Party since 1995.

Scope

Comprehensive commitment to address in a **synergistic and ambitious** manner the environmental challenges faced by the country in terms of climate change, biodiversity and desertification.

It will focus exclusively on the commitments established in the **NDCs**, the **NBSAP** and the **NDTs**. It will not include specific operational details of each commitment.



Strategic access to funds and optimization of resources for high-impact projects.




EXPANDING AMBITION

Effective coordination and international credibility of the country in climate actions.




IMPLEMENTATION EFFICIENCY AND IMPROVEMENTS

Strategic alliances and multisectoral commitment to the country's environmental goals.




SOCIOECONOMIC RESILIENCE

Reduced climate vulnerability, increased food security and sustainable economy.




Nature Pledge Structure Proposal
