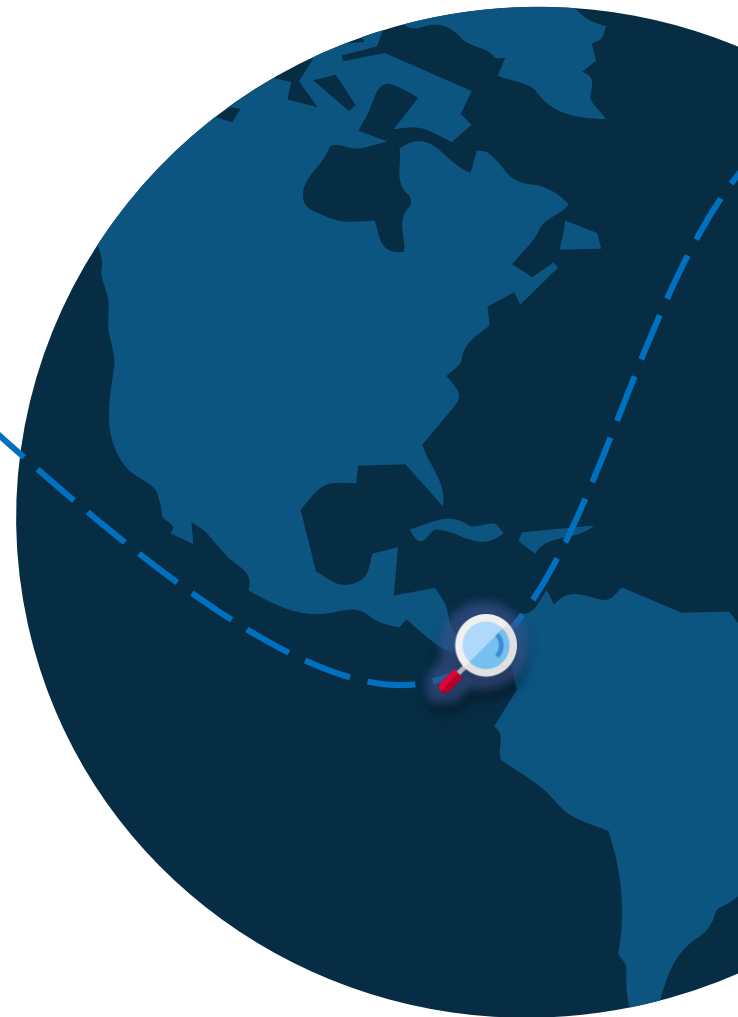


PANAMA'S *NATURE PLEDGE*

Climate change, desertification and biodiversity loss are strongly interrelated and pose existential challenges to humanity. In response to these challenges, Panama, as a leading green and blue country, presents its **Nature Pledge**, a strategic framework that maximizes synergies among the three Rio Conventions to which the country has been a Party since 1995.

What is it?

Comprehensive commitment to address in a **synergistic and ambitious** manner the environmental challenges faced by the country in terms of climate change, biodiversity and desertification.

Scope

It will focus exclusively on the commitments established in the **NDCs**, the **NBSAP** and the **NDTs**. It will not include specific operational details of each commitment.

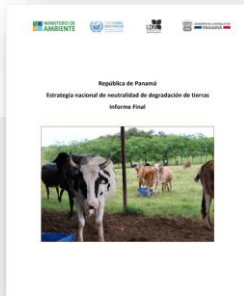

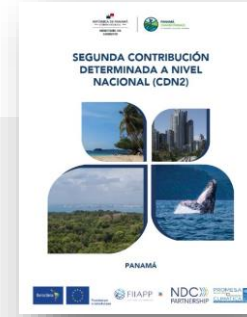

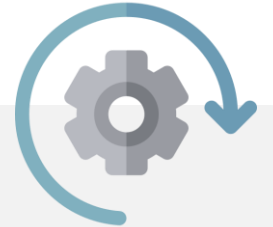

CO₂ Emissions Reduction



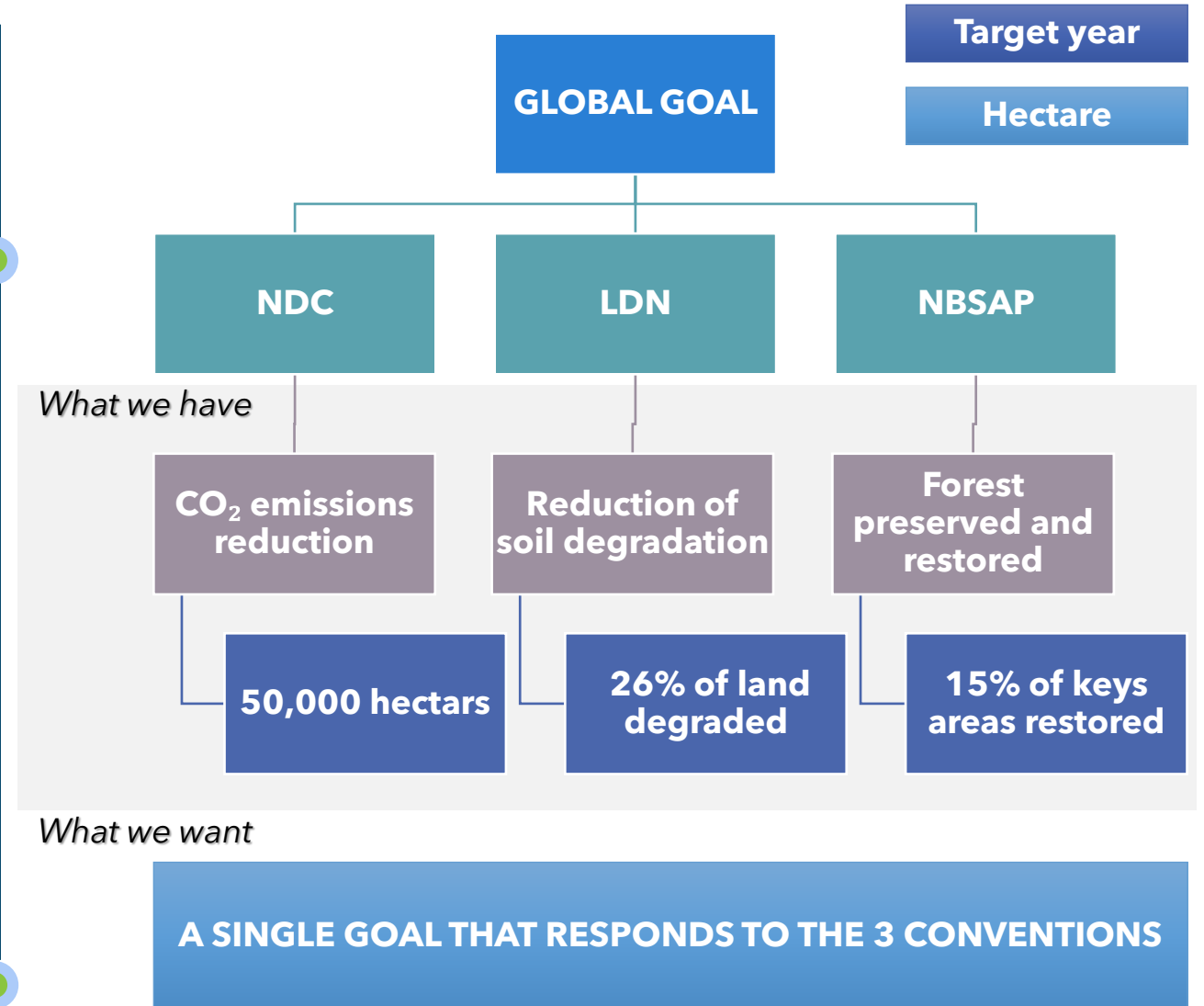
Soil degradation reduction measures

Effective coordination and international credibility of the country in climate actions.



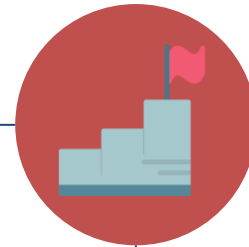
COLLABORATION BETWEEN KEY PLAYERS

Strategic alliances and multisectoral commitment to the country's environmental goals.



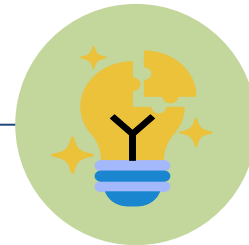

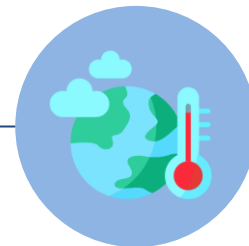

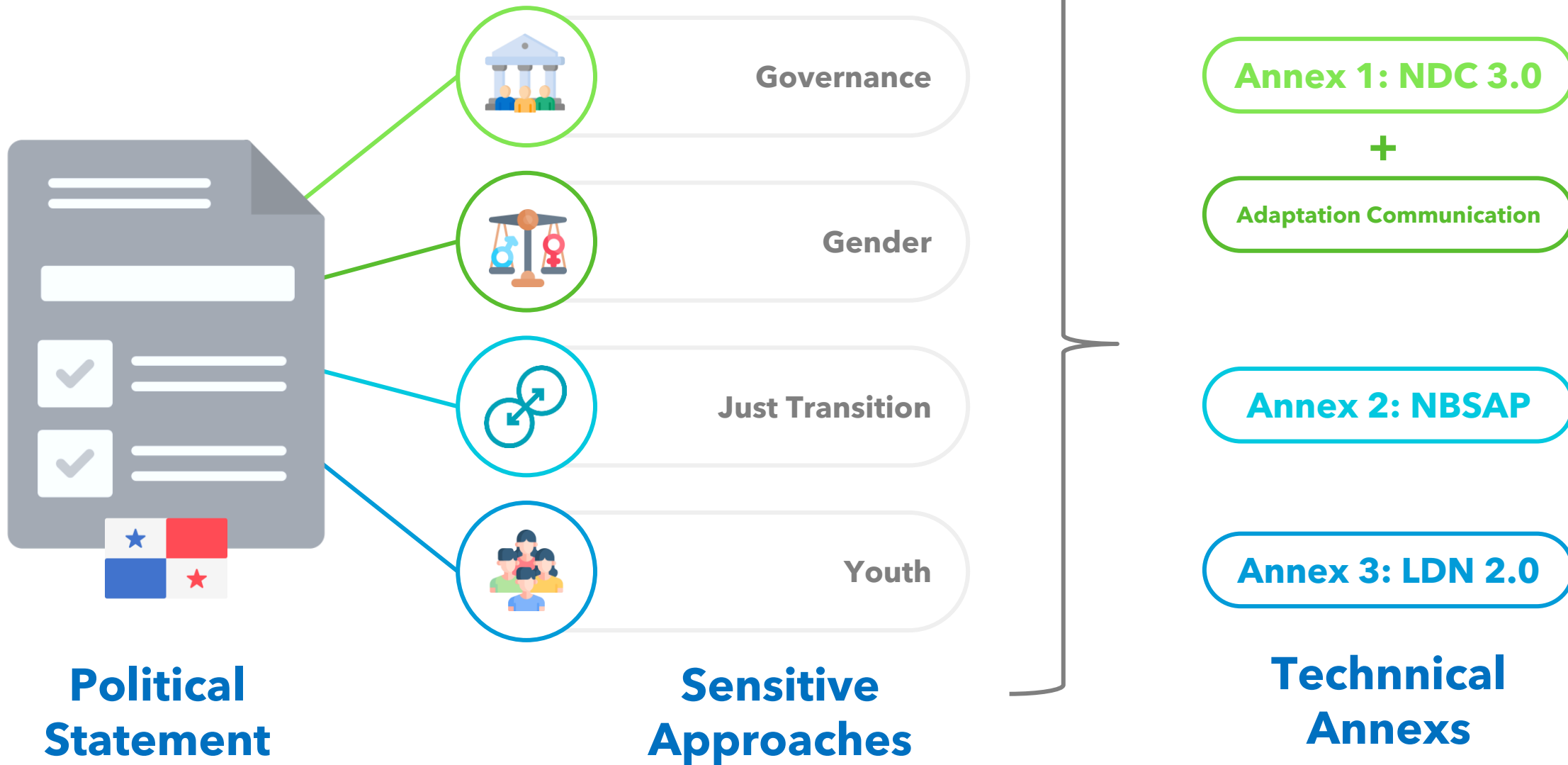
