Purpose

Country priorities and available forms of financing changes as a country transition, offering differentiated solutions to shared challenges. It is essential that we have a common framework that speaks to low-income countries as well as middle and high-income countries, allowing for different pathways depending on the starting point and capabilities, but not compromising with the global goals of both poverty reduction and addressing climate change.
