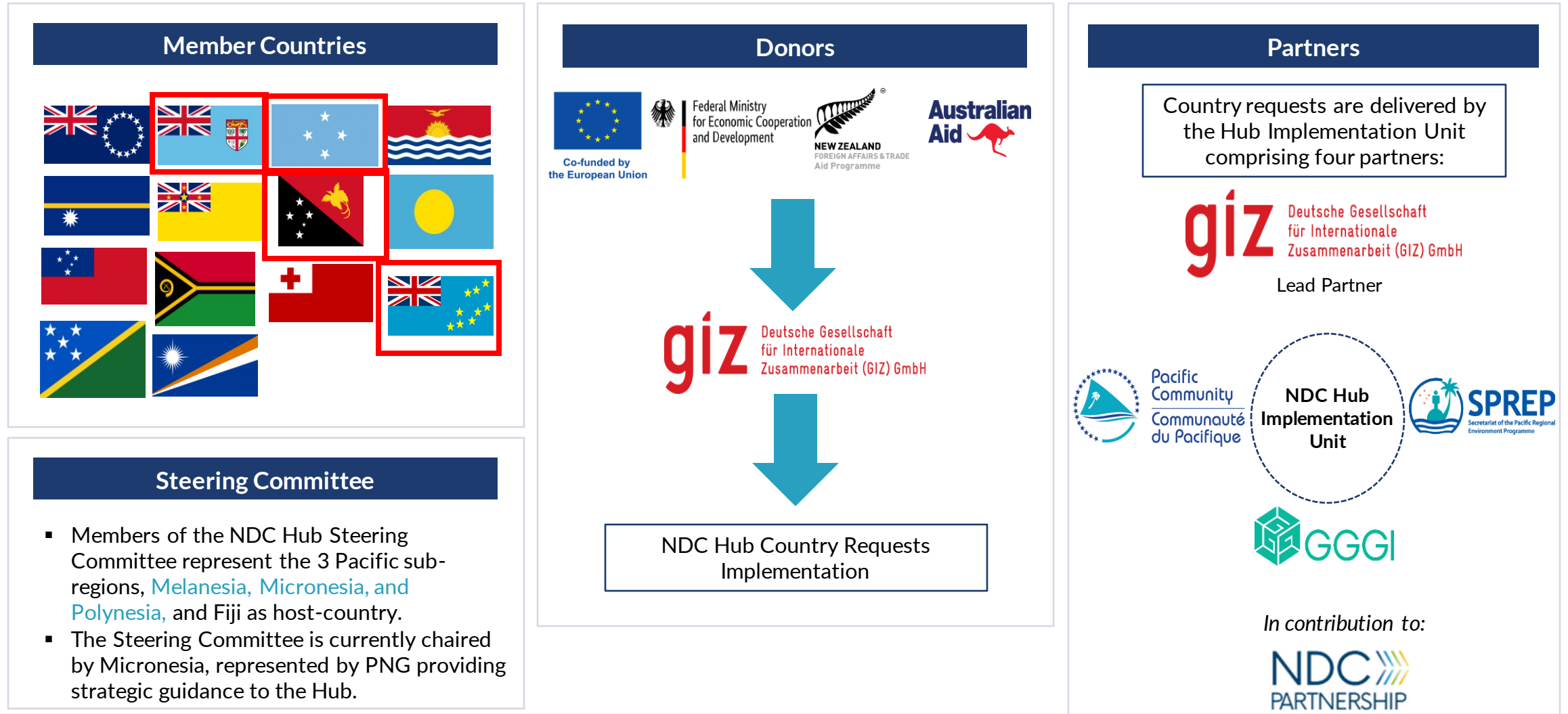

3



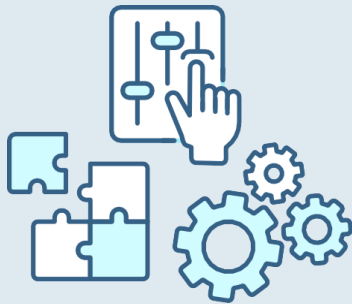
The Implementation Unit identifies experts and consults with the country on the suitability of the intervention

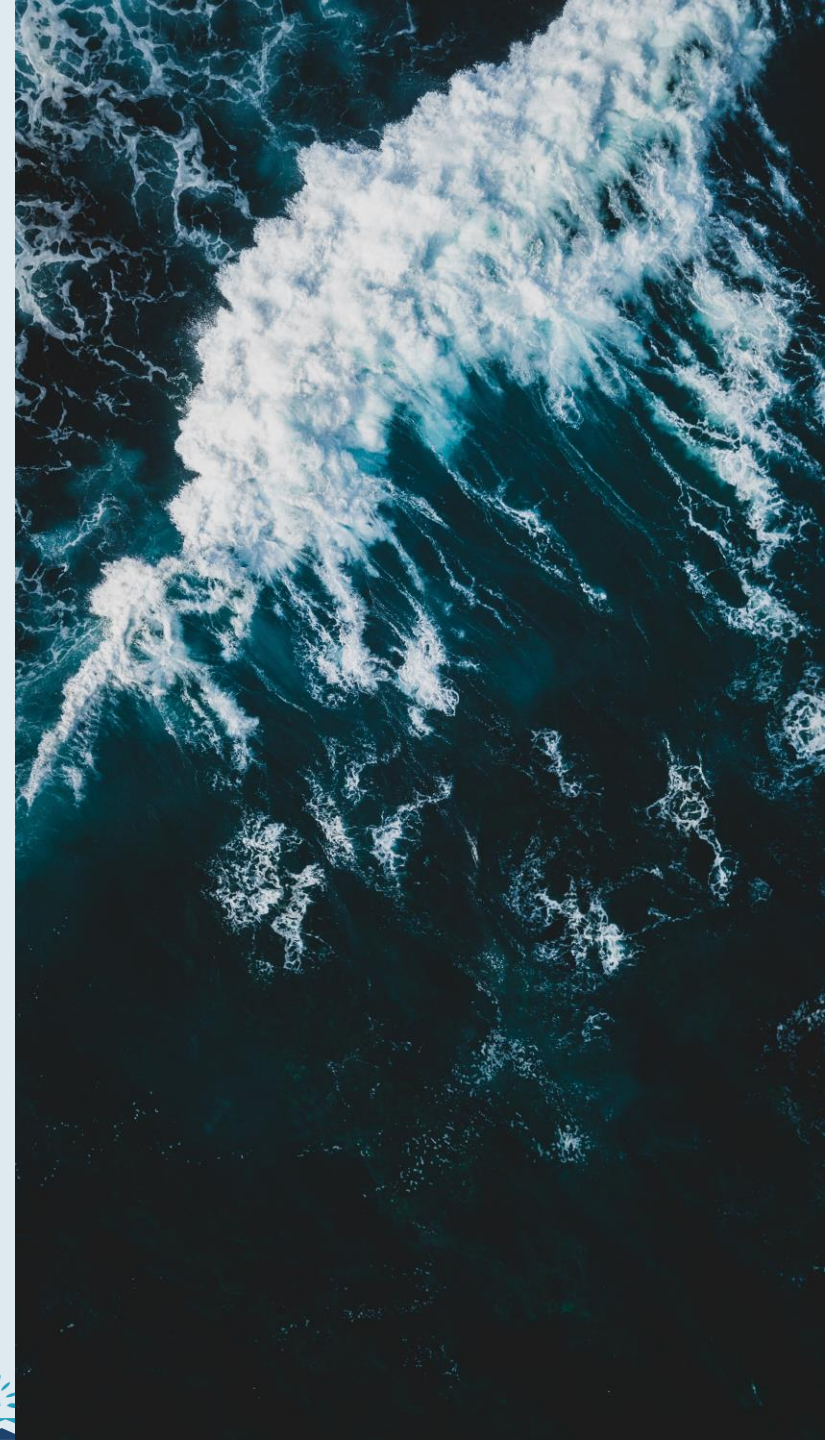

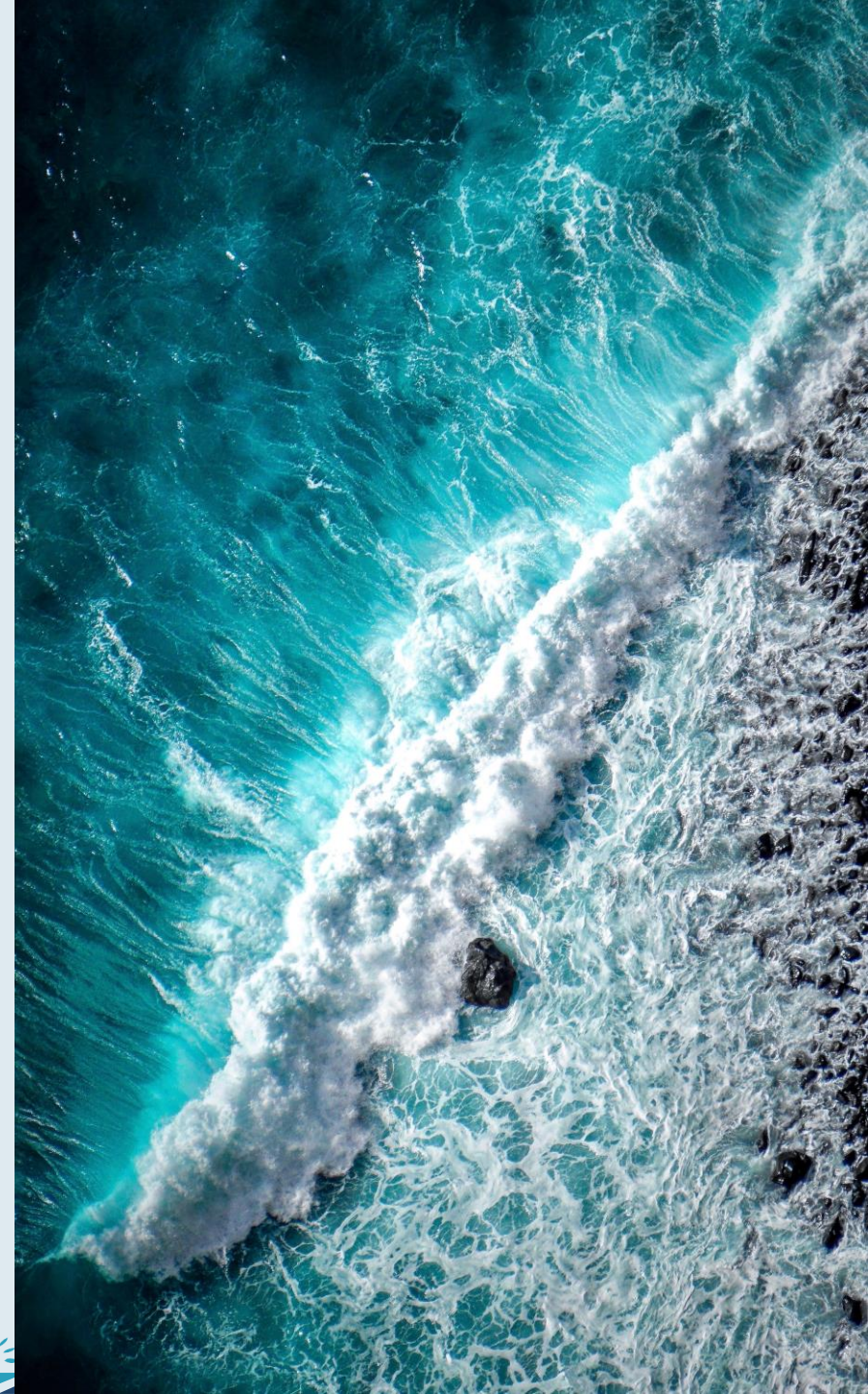
