



Call for interest in developing regional case studies on the just transition of the workforce and the creation of decent and quality jobs, as well as on economic diversification and transformation, in collaboration with KCI as part of activity 11 of the 2026-2030 work plan.

2. Brief description of the proposed study:

Brief description of activities This call for interest seeks to identify qualified regional experts, institutions or organizations to develop case studies on the just transition of the workforce, the creation of decent and quality jobs, and economic diversification and transformation, in support of Activity 11 of the KCI 2026–2030 work plan.

Selected contributors will be expected to carry out the following activities: 1. Desk review – Analyze existing national/regional policies, strategies, and initiatives related to just transition, decent work, and economic diversification in the selected region. 2. Case study identification – Select 2–3 illustrative examples (sectoral, national, or sub-regional) that demonstrate good practices, innovative approaches, challenges, or lessons learned in advancing a just transition and diversified, resilient economies. 3. Stakeholder consultations – Engage relevant actors (government agencies, workers' and employers' organizations, private sector, civil society) through interviews, surveys, or consultations to gather first-hand data and perspectives. 4. Drafting – Produce structured case study reports (following a template to be provided by the KCI secretariat), covering context, policy measures, implementation outcomes, gaps, and recommendations. 5. Review and validation – Present preliminary findings for feedback, including through virtual consultations and/or a regional validation workshop organized in collaboration with the KCI. 6. Finalization and dissemination – Incorporate feedback and finalize case studies for publication, to serve as inputs to KCI activities, UNFCCC in-session events, and other relevant knowledge-sharing platforms.
