1. The 26th meeting of the facilitative branch of the Compliance Committee of the Kyoto Protocol will be opened by the chairperson of the branch.

2. Members and alternate members of the branch will be invited to introduce themselves briefly.

3. Adoption of the agenda and organization of work

- 3. In conformity with rule 7 of the rules of procedure of the Committee¹, the branch will be invited to consider and adopt the provisional agenda for this meeting, annotated in the present document (document CC/FB/26/2023/1).
- 4. The branch will also be invited to consider the indicative schedule to conduct its work, as presented by the chairperson of the branch, for agreement.

4. Provisions related to facilitation: Advice and facilitation

- 5. In accordance with section VI, paragraph 3 of the procedures and mechanisms relating to compliance under the Kyoto Protocol², and paragraph 49 of the Guidelines for review under Article 8 of the Kyoto Protocol³, the secretariat forwards the reports on the individual reviews of the annual submissions by Parties (ARRs) to the Committee as published. At its 25th meeting, the branch agreed to continue the review of the 2021 and 2022 ARRs in the context of its overall mandate and functions and to facilitate this task, also agreed to conduct an online session training on the "General Analysis and Overview tool⁴.
- 6. Members and alternate members will be invited to present the outcomes of their reviews of the ARRs, and the branch will be invited to consider them, as well as the experience gained in reviewing ARRs, and agree upon the working arrangements to review the remaining ARRs in preparation for its 27th meeting.
- 7. At its 24th meeting⁵, the branch decided to update the document *Experience of the facilitative branch of the Kyoto Protocol Compliance Committee in providing advice and facilitation to Parties in implementing the Kyoto Protocol⁶. At its 25th meeting, the branch considered a presentation by the secretariat on the possible approach and methodology to conducting that update*
